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MINUTES OF MEETING

January 9, 1990 at 5:00 PM

All members of the council was present at the January 9, meeting. They were, Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Maxine Stamey, CJ Baker, Paul Pope and Eddie Wilson.

There was no correction to the last minutes. Paul Pope made the motion to pay all bills. Max Andrews seconded with all in favor.

Mayor Bill Ramsey opened the public hearing on the purchase of the Holden property. As there was no opposition to the sale, Eddie Wilson made the motion for the town to buy the property on the term approved by the board. Maxine Stamey seconded this motion with all in favor. Max Andrews made the motion to have a special meeting on Friday, January 12th at 5:00 with members of the Sawmills Optimist Club to discuss the distribution of the property between the town and the Optimist club. Maxine Stamey seconded. All were in favor. Public hearing was then closed.

Paul Pope made the motion to pay Arnold Arrowood and Ronnie Coffey for their vacation time not taken in 1989, with the exception that it will be mandatory to take vacations in the future or loose them, without pay. Motion was seconded by CJ Baker. All were in favor.

CJ Baker made the motion to ask Western Piedmont Council of Governments to assist in setting up a filing system for the town. Eddie Wilson seconded with all in favor.

Maxine Stamey made the motion for Arnold Arrowood to get specs of a 25 yard bed, dual axle garbage truck. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

Max Andrews made the motion to put the renters deposits money into an interest bearing account, requiring two signatures. CJ Baker seconded this motion with all in favor. Motion was made by Paul Pope to put the water department account into an interest bearing account. Seconded by CJ Baker. All were in favor.

The placing of a guard rail on Ruel Drive was tabled.

Max Andrews made the motion to pass an ordinance to lower the speed limit on SR1130 and on SR1118. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

After some discussion the board decided to leave Baker Circle named as is.

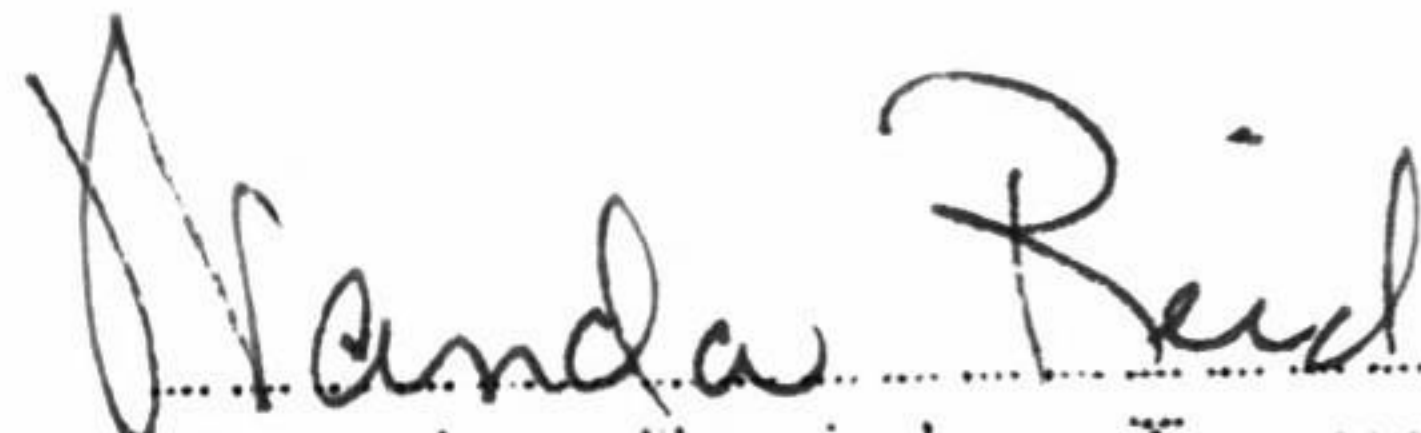
Maxine Stamey made the motion to go into executive session.

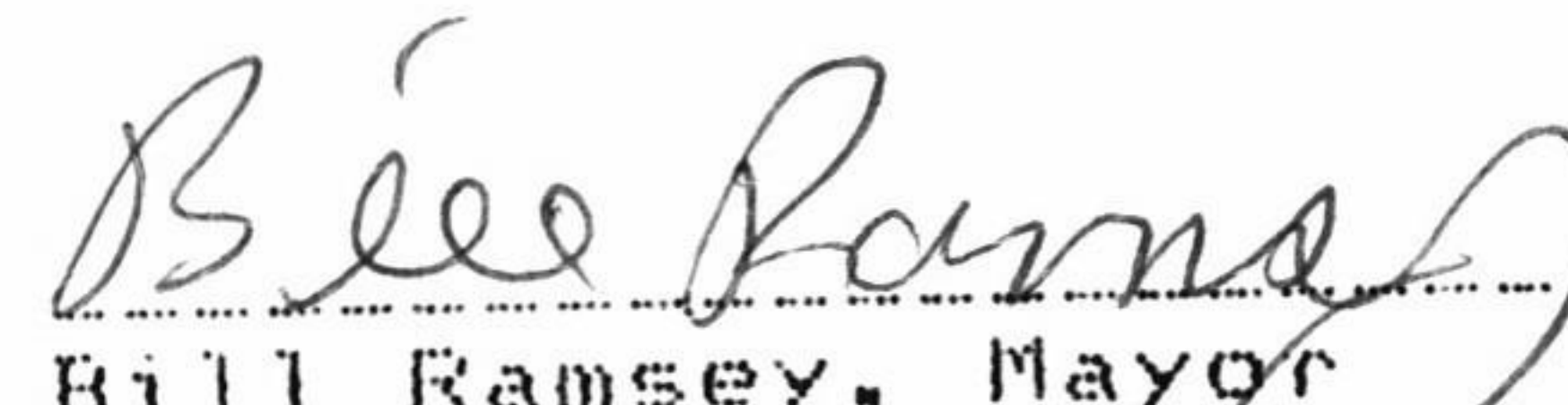
Motion was seconded by Eddie Wilson. Paul Pope made the motion to come out of executive session. Seconding this motion was Max Andrews. All were in favor.
