

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONTINUATION OF ARC

WHEREAS, the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) was created by Congress in 1965 to provide assistance to one of the country's most economically distressed regions, the Appalachian Mountain Area; and

WHEREAS, ARC has made enormous strides to overcome the poverty and hopelessness of the residents of the Appalachian region by providing funds to improve roads, housing, education, community development and health care, and by attracting public and private investments; and

WHEREAS, these projects have improved the quality of life and economic health and have given hope to citizens in the Unifour Appalachian Counties of Alexander, Burke and Caldwell; and

WHEREAS, due to the efforts of ARC, fewer people in Alexander, Burke and Caldwell are living in poverty, per capita income has risen, more people are getting a high school education and infant mortality has been reduced; yet

WHEREAS, the mission of ARC is not complete. Many areas within the Appalachian counties of our region as well as across Appalachia still have infrastructure, as well as economic and human development needs; and

WHEREAS, funds provided by other sources such as HUD, Farmers Home Administration and EPA have been drastically reduced, threatening the progress ARC has helped bring about; and

WHEREAS, ARC has proven to be a viable program that has made a difference in our ARC Counties of Alexander, Burke and Caldwell and elsewhere in North Carolina, as well as the other 12 states; and

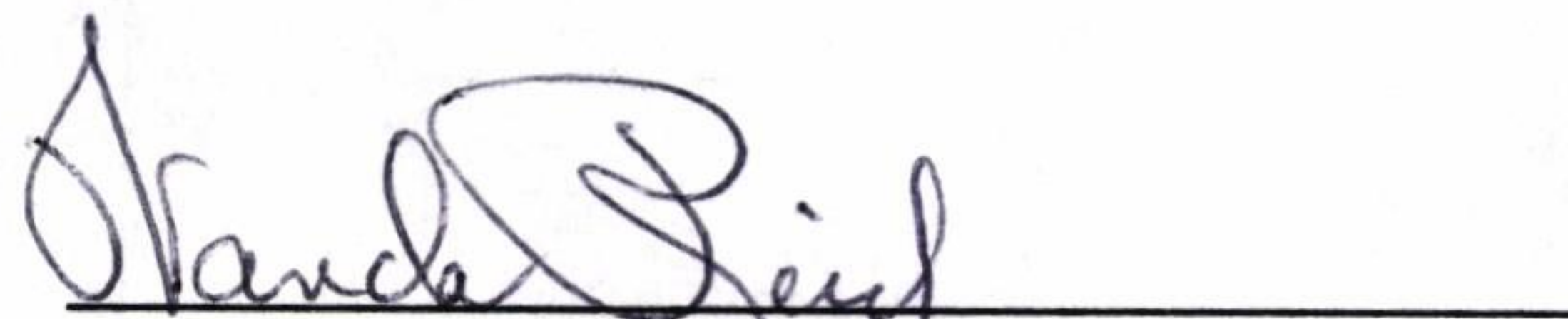

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF SAWMILLS, NC.

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio has completed the 1994 S-3 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Sawmills, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general nature enacted since the prior supplement to the Code of Ordinances of this municipality; and

WHEREAS, said American Legal Publishing Corporation has recommended the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or make references to sections of the North Carolina general Statutes 160A-et., al Code; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of council to accept these updated sections in accordance with the changes of the law to the State of North Carolina;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Sawmills, North Carolina Code of Ordinances as submitted by American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, and as attached hereto, be and the same is hereby adopted by reference as if set out in its entirety.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its date of passage.
