

TOWN OF SAWMILLS MINUTES
JANUARY 19, 1993, 5:00 pm at TOWN HALL

Mayor Pro-tem Max Andrews opened the meeting with Mayor Bill Ramsey absent. Present were: Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood and Tim Sanders.

Invocation was given by Dennis Wilson.

c., Dry Ponds and Sawmills School road intersection, d., voluntary annexation of the Gregory and Melody Wilson property, and e., dial pagers were added to the agenda. Tim Sanders made a motion to adopt the agenda with changes. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

Tim Sanders made a motion that the minutes of January 5, 1993 be approved. Larry Prestwood seconded with all in favor.

At 5:09 pm, the public hearing on the voluntary annexation of the Ralph and Pearl Dula, Steven Dula, and Sammy and Gail Dula property was opened. As there was no opposition, Tim Sanders made a motion to close the public hearing at 5:14, pm. Motion was seconded by Paul Pope. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to approve the annexation of the Dula property.

Larry Prestwood made a motion to purchase tools needed for the maintenance shop from Harbor Freight. Dennis Wilson seconded. All were in favor.

Larry Prestwood made a motion to call for a public hearing on the voluntary annexation of the Gregory and Melody Wilson property (approximately 1.17 acres) for February 2, 1993, town hall at 5:00 pm. All were in favor as Dennis Wilson seconded.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to pay all bills, except Water Tech Laboratories for \$1, 187.00. This bill will be paid with the town signs a contract with Water Tech and is provided with license and certification.

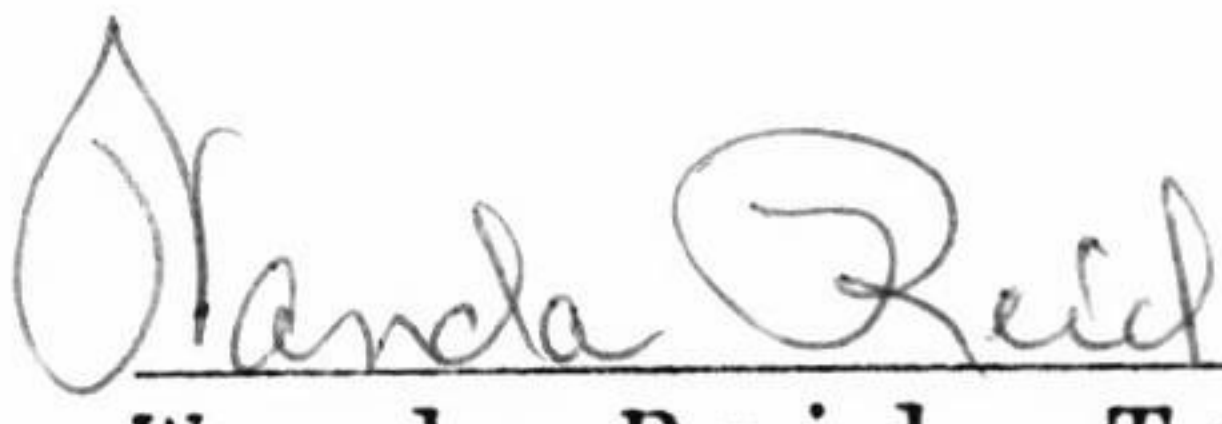
Tim Sanders made a motion to lease dial pagers for the public works director, assistant public works director and one general laborer, at \$13. 00 a month with a pager protection plan of \$15.00 per unit per year, which carries a deductible of \$50.00 with the understanding of each employee, that if the pager is lost or damaged, the employee will be required to pay the \$50.00 deductible. Paul Pope seconded. All in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to advertise for a full time position as general laborer, starting wage \$6.00 per hour, until the end of month.

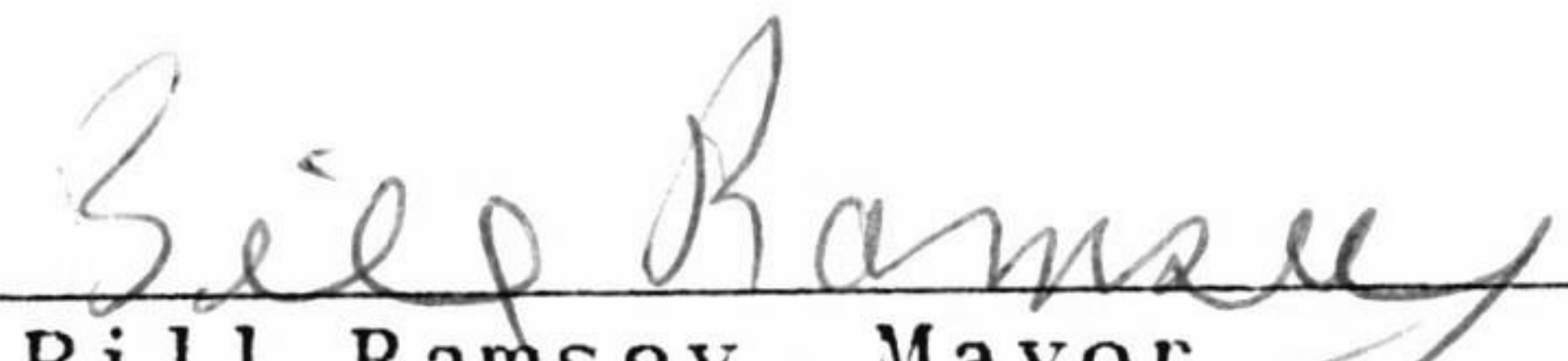
