

TOWN OF SAWMILLS
MINUTES OF MEETING
January 22, 1991

All councilmembers were present at the regular meeting held January 22, 1991 at 5:00 PM at town hall. Mayor Bill Ramsey presided.

The Rev. Ed Warren gave the invocation.

Minutes of the last meeting were approved as distributed.

At 5:03 PM a public hearing was opened on the closing out of the CDGB grant to look at a water study and housing needs. Since no one appeared to oppose the close out, Paul Pope made the motion that the hearing be closed. Dare Duncan seconded, with all in favor.

At 5:18 PM, a public hearing was opened on the Code of Ordinance manual. On a motion made by Eddie Wilson, seconded by Max Andrews, council moved to adopt the Code of Ordinance. All were in favor. Dare Duncan made the motion to close the public hearing at 5:26 PM. Seconding this motion was Paul Pope. All were in favor. The motion to adopt procedures for enforcing the Code of Ordinance was made by Paul Pope with CJ Baker seconding. All were in favor.

CJ Baker made the motion to allow 90 days to pay on excessive water bills. This only applies to broken water lines. Eddie Wilson seconded with all in favor.

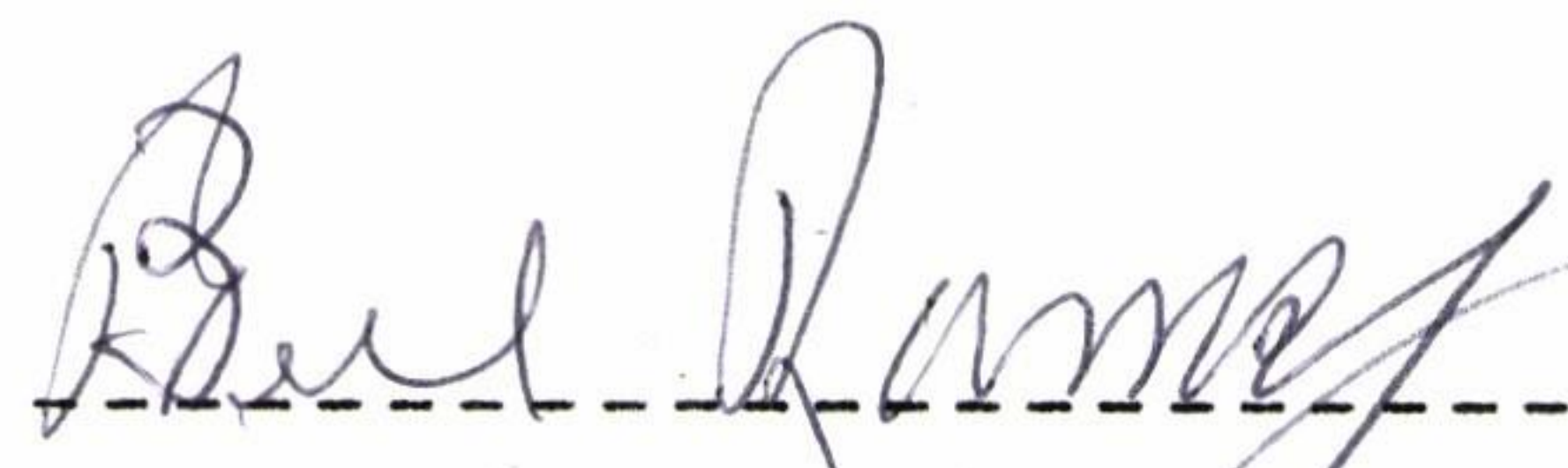
