

TOWN OF SAWMILLS
MINUTES OF MEETING
JANUARY 28, 1992

All council members were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. They were; Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Larry Prestwood, Dennis Wilson and Tim Sanders.

Dennis Wilson gave the invocation.

Paul Pope made a motion to adopt the agenda. Larry Prestwood seconded, with all in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to change the figure of \$1,864.00 to \$3,728.00 as reported on the minutes of January 14, 1992 concerning the Town of Sawmills share of the budget on the Upper River Water Quality Action being conducted by Western Piedmont Council of Government.

Dennis Wilson made a motion to award Brown Steel Contractor's bid of \$241,000.00 for a 250,000 gallon elevated water storage tank. Motion was seconded by Paul Pope, with all in favor.

Larry Prestwood made a motion to award Carolina Demolition & Grading's bid of \$32,331.25 to do the water lines. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Dennis Wilson, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to approve the contract with Chester West of West and Associates, P.A. for engineering services of the above projects. Mr. West related to the board that the projects should be completed within six to nine months time.

The tipping fee policy was tabled until the February 11, 1992 meeting.

The Consent Agreement between the Town of Sawmills and the Sawmills Optimist Club, and the Sublease Agreement between the Sawmills Optimist Club, and the Sawmills Jaycees was tabled until the next meeting.

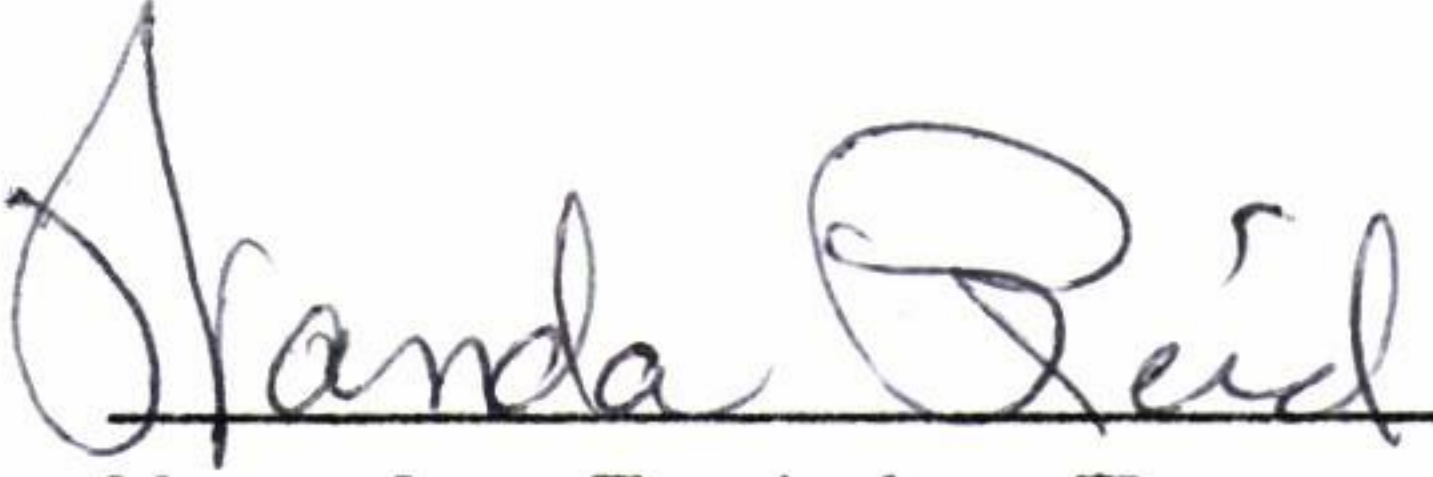

After a lengthy discussion on recycling, Larry Prestwood made a motion to submit plans to Sam Ervin of Western Piedmont Council of Government to apply for a \$15,000.00 recycling grant in order for the town to try recycling on its own. Dennis Wilson, seconded with all in favor.

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On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to have a special meeting on January 30, 1992 at 9:00 AM with Sam Ervin to apply for the grant.

At 6:10 PM, Tim Sanders made a motion to adjourn. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

A special meeting was held Thursday, January 30, 1992 at 9:00 AM at town hall.

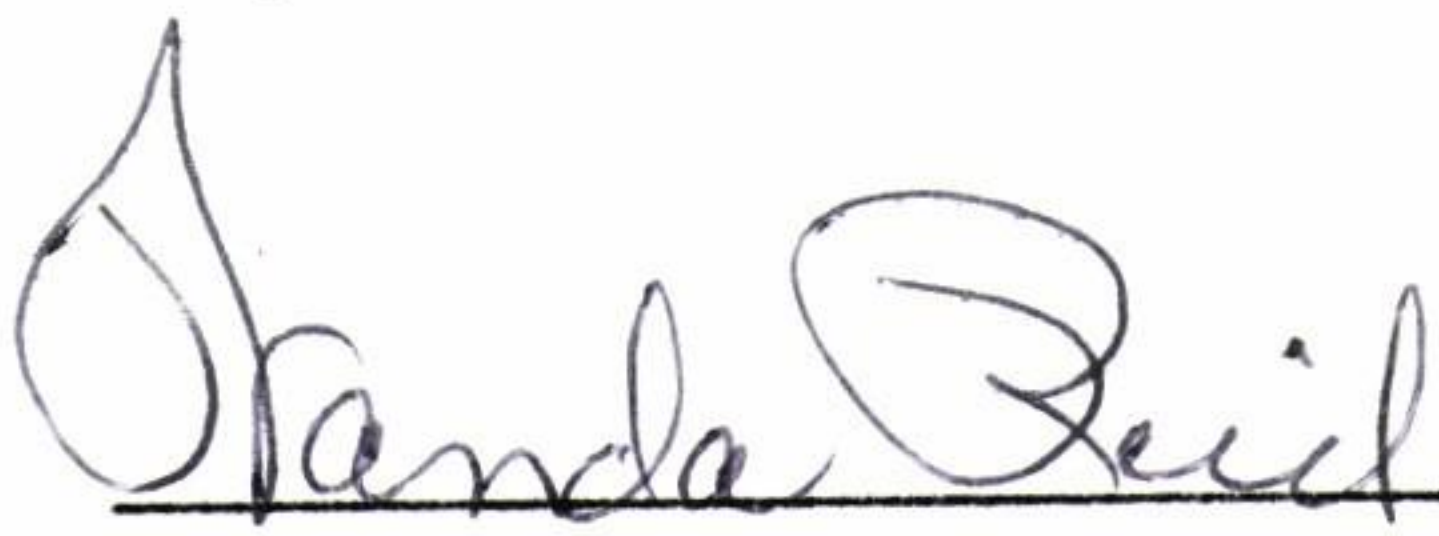

Sam Ervin with Western Piedmont Council of Governments discussed with the board the procedures of applying for a \$15,000.00 recycling grant. The papers for this grant must be postmarked no later than February 8, 1992. Mr Ervin stressed to the board that the town needs to show that it is willing to spend money of its own. Also that it needed to be advertised to the residents of Sawmills about two months before starting the recycling program.

Mayor Bill Ramsey arrived at the meeting at 9:30 AM.

On a motion made by Larry Prestwood, seconded by Tim Sanders, council moved to have another special meeting on February 6, 1992 at 9:00 AM to go over the grant proposal.

Larry Prestwoods made the motion to adjourn at 9:40 AM. Paul Pope seconded, with all in favor.
