

TOWN OF SAWMILLS MINUTES OF MEETING
FEBRUARY 2, 1993, 5:00 pm at TOWN HALL

All commissioners were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. They were: Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood, and Tim Sanders.

Invocation was given by Rev. Edd Warren.

d., Ms Virginia Godfrey was added to the agenda. Max Andrews made a motion to approve the agenda with changes. Dennis Wilson seconded. All were in favor.

Tim Sanders made a motion to approve the January 19, 1993 minutes. Paul Pope seconded with all in favor.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Max Andrews, council moved to pay the bills.

Max Andrews made a motion to accept the contract with Water'Tech Laboratories. Paul Pope seconded. Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, and Larry Prestwood voted for and Tim Sanders voted against.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to provide catch basins and the town do the needed work in running a ditch to divert water off Ms Virginia Godfrey's property, with Ms Godfrey supplying the pipe.

At 5:45 pm, the public hearing was opened on the voluntary annexation of Gregory and Melody Wilson. As there was no opposition, Tim Sanders made a motion to close public hearing, at 5:46 pm. Larry Prestwood seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Dennis Wilson, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to approve the annexation of the Wilson property, effective February 2, 1993.

Larry Prestwood made a motion to advertise for formal bids for a street department truck, to be opened during the March 2, 1993 meeting. Tim Sanders seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to deny a request for a permit to open a beach bingo polar in the old Kohler-Campbell building.

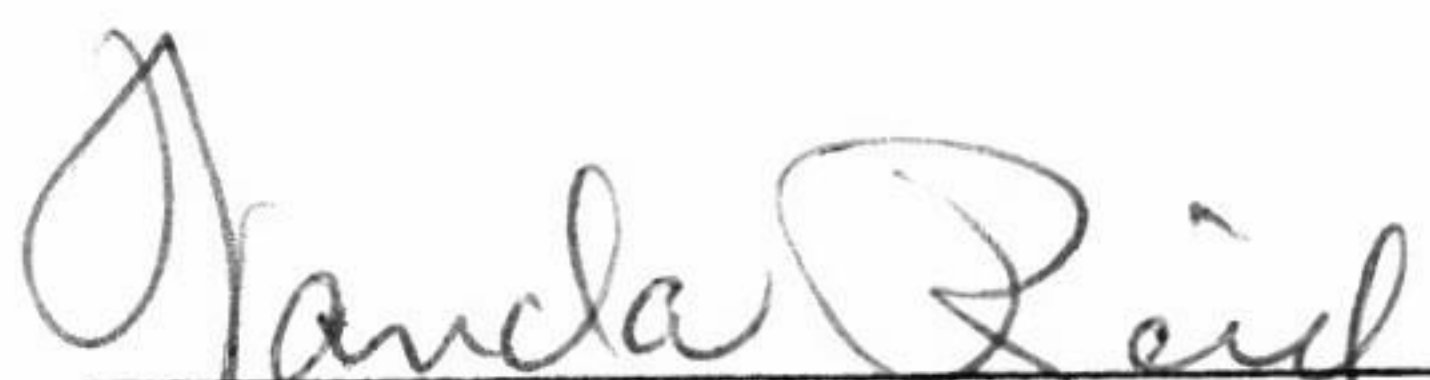
Dennis Wilson made a motion to hire David Watson full time at \$6.00 per hour, as general laborer. Larry Prestwood seconded. All were in favor.

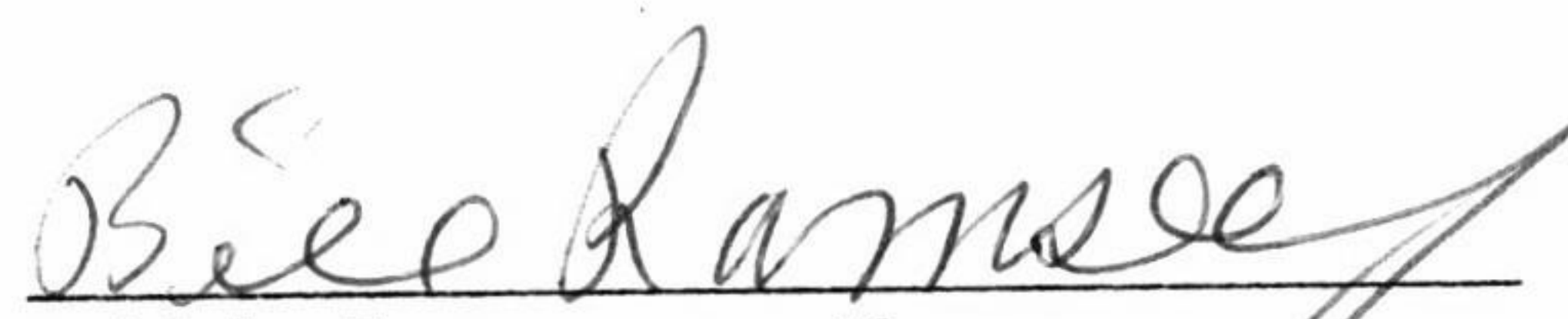

The Caldwell County Commissioners will be meeting in local communities throughout the county. Sawmills will host their first meeting on February 15, 1993 at 7:00 pm at Sawmills Elementary School gymnasium. On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to provide refreshments.

Tim Sanders made a motion that the town of Sawmills join with Caldwell County Commissioners and the city of Lenoir in a proposal that CitCom return WSPA Spartenburg to channel 7, and CBS to where it once was and move CCC&TI to channel 5. Relocating showtime to channel 37 and the expanded tier, where CitCom proposed to cut the CCC&TI channel. The Caldwell County Commissioners will not waive our rights to community access on the basic tier. That CitCom would reconsider their decision to swap ESPN and QBC network with WHKY Hickory on the system that there is already enough shop at home programs available. That CitCom would add local news 53A0 to a lower power TV station license in Lenoir to its line up. Larry Prestwood seconded. All were in favor.

Tim Sanders made a motion to adjourn at 6:15 pm. Larry Prestwood seconded. All were in favor.
