

TOWN OF SAWMILLS
MINUTES OF MEETING
FEBRUARY 12, 1991
5:00 PM at Town Hall

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Bill Ramsey with all councilpersons present. They were, Bill Ramsey, Max Andrew, CJ Baker, Paul Pope, Eddie Wilson and Dare Duncan.

Rev. Rick Crouse gave the invocation.

Minutes of the last minutes were approved. Councilman CJ Baker made the motion to pay all outstanding bills. Councilman Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

The purchasing of Christmas decorations was tabled until the next meeting.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Dare Duncan, seconded by Councilman Eddie Wilson to purchase two Regency Walkie Talkies, with drop in chargers and carrying case, for \$625.00 each. Paul Pope, Eddie Wilson and Dare Duncan was in favor. Councilman CJ Baker abstained and Councilman Max Andrews voted against it.

On a motion made by CJ Baker, seconded by Eddie Wilson, council moved to change the street named Granville Terrace to Crest Lane.

The towns purchasing of numbers to be placed on each home in the Town of Sawmills was tabled until the next meeting.

Councilman Paul Pope made the motion to place an ad in the Lenoir News Topic's governmental section for the last Saturday in February. Max Andrews seconded. All were in favor.

Councilman CJ Baker made the motion to place a 2" water meter on Walter Moore's property and that Mr. Moore pay all expenses to run water lines to the Moore Farm. Councilman Eddie Wilson seconded. All were in favor. Motion was made by Eddie Wilson, seconded by Paul Pope to charge double rates for the farms water usage. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Councilman Eddie Wilson, seconded by Councilman CJ Baker, council moved to purchase shrubbery and flowers at the cost of \$300.00 to be placed around Sawmills Elementary School.

At 6:04 PM, CJ Baker made the motion to adjourn. Dare Duncan seconded. All were in favor.
