

TOWN OF SAWMILLS MINUTES OF MEETING
FEBRUARY 16, 1993-5:00 pm at TOWN HALL

Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood, and Tim Sanders were all present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order.

Invocation was given by Rev. Edd Warren.

d., Park Funding, change item b. from Recall Legislation to b., Lenoir News Topic e., Recall Legislation f., to Faith Spool and item g., to Recycling Bins. Tim Sanders made a motion to adopt agenda with changes and Larry Prestwood seconded. Vote unanimous.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to approve the February 2, 1993 minutes. Paul Pope made a motion to pay all bills. Mayor Pro-Tem Max Andrews seconded, with all in favor.

Tim Sanders made a motion to approve Ms. Mary Wilson's minor subdivision located off Marcus Dr., as presented by Town Planner, Mike Legg. All were in favor as Dennis Wilson seconded.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to call a public hearing on March 16, 1993 for rezoning on the property owned by Walter Moore, located at the end of Cloer Drive. This property is zoned R-15 and Mr Moore wants to build another room at Caisey's and in order to do this, it needs to be zoned Neighborhood Business.

Dennis Wilson made a motion to deny a request from the Lenoir News Topic of placing an ad in the Progress Edition at the price of \$448.50. Paul Pope seconded with all in favor.

Larry Prestwood made a motion that letters be sent to the businesses and churches in the town, informing them of the State of North Carolina Building Code Councils adoption of a new law last year that requires each structure be inspected on a periodic basis by certified fire inspectors approved by the State of North Carolina. Tim Sanders seconded. All were in favor.

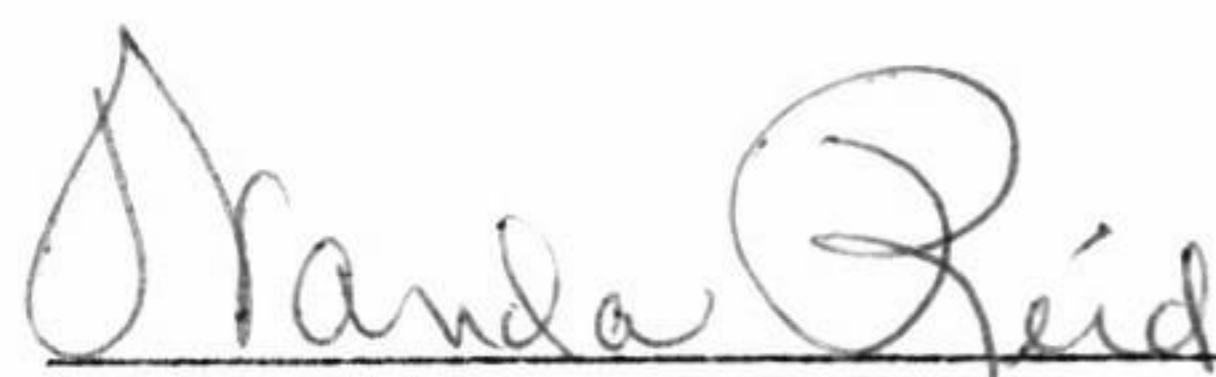
The park funding was tabled until the next meeting.

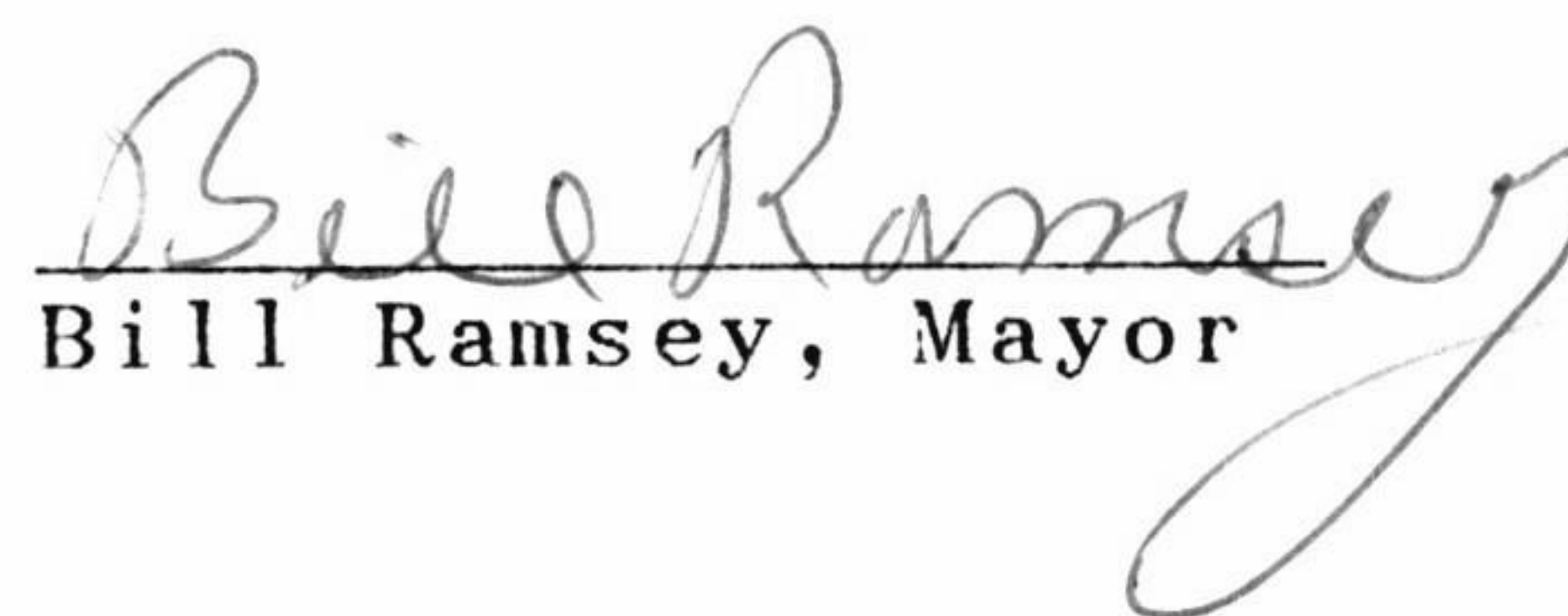
On a motion made by Paul Pope seconded by Tim Sanders, council moved that the town buy the material and the town employees do the work in putting in a septic tank at the new park.

Dennis Wilson made a motion to purchase more recycling bins at the price of \$1,861.20. Larry Prestwood seconded with all in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to adjourn at 6:55 pm.
