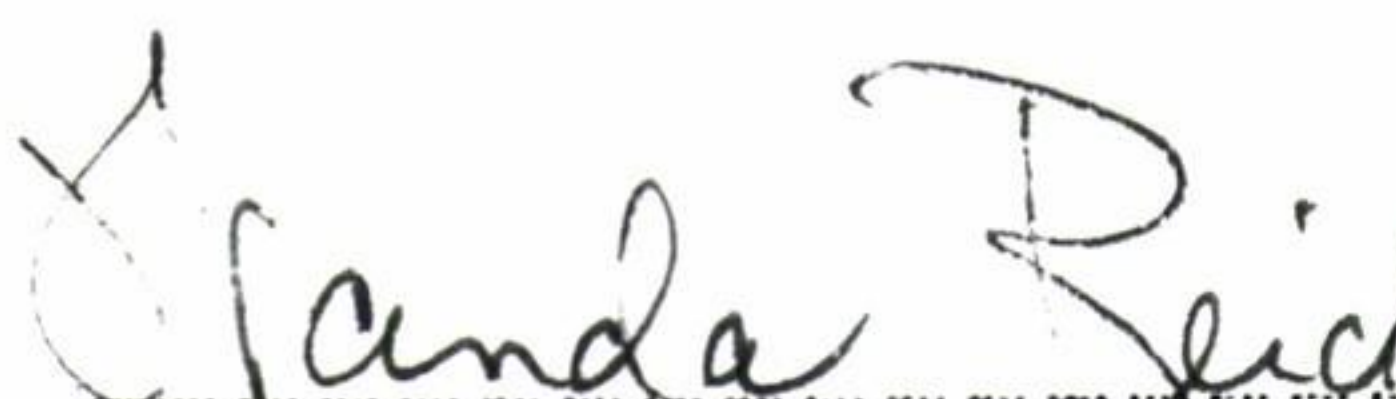
Eddie Wilson made the motion to change White Pine MHP street sign to White Pine Drive. Seconded by Maxine Stamey. All were in favor.
