MINUTES OF MEETING
MARCH 12, 1991
5:00 PM AT TOWN HALL

The regular meeting of the Town of Sawmills was held at town hall on Tuesday, March 12, 1991. Present were, Bill Ramsey, CJ Baker, Paul Pope, Eddie Wilson, and Dare Duncan. Max Andrews was away on town business.

Invocation was given by Rev. Fred Hicks.

Minutes of the previous meeting was approved. Councilman Baker made the motion to pay the bills. Paul Pope seconded with all in favor.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dare Duncan, council moved to purchase four-digit numbers for each house and mobile home, in the Town of Sawmills, needed to implement the 911 telephone service. Council decided to use black aluminum numbers for houses and pull-off sticker numbers for mobile homes. All were in favor.

Mayor Bill Ramsey opened the public hearing for the purpose of considering an amendment to the zoning ordinance. Don Albert planner, for the Town of Sawmills, explained to the board that the proposed change would permit kennels in the Highway Business District as a conditional use. The conditions would be determined by the Sawmills Board of Adjustment as deemed necessary to ensure the health, safety, and general welfare of the community. Public hearing was then closed.

Councilmember Paul Pope made the motion to approve a conditional permit, previously approved by the Sawmills Planning Board, for an extension of twelve runs as requested by Mull Haus Kennels. Eddie Wilson seconded with all in favor.

Councilwoman Dare Duncan made the motion to accept the amendment to the zoning ordinance, seconded by Councilman CJ Baker. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Eddie Wilson, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to call a public hearing on March 26, 1991 at 5:00 PM, concerning a CDGB Grant application for housing rehabilitation, water, street improvement on Baird Dr.

Councilmember Eddie Wilson made the motion that if an employee of the Town of Sawmills was called to serve on jury duty that the employee would be paid for a regular forty hour week, no overtime, and that any payment received by employee for this duty be returned to the town. Motion was seconded by Councilwoman Dare Duncan. All were in favor.

CJ Baker made the motion to adjourn at 6:15 PM. Motion was seconded by Dare Duncan. All were in favor.
