TOWN OF SAWMILLS, MINUTES OF MEETING
MARCH 16, 1993, 5:00 pm at TOWN HALL

The following members were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. They were: Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood and Tim Sanders.

Councilman Dennis Wilson gave the invocation.

After adding a., HOME Program on New Business, Tim Sanders moved the council adopt the agenda, seconded by Paul Pope. Unanimous vote.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved the minutes of March 2 be approved.

At 5:05 pm the public hearing was opened on the Walter and Carolyn Moore property, off Cloer Drive. This property is zoned R-15 and the Moore's wish the zoning be changed to Neighborhood Business, in order to build another room to Caisey's Fish Camp.

After some discussion, at 5:21 pm, motion was made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood to close the public hearing. All were in favor.

Paul Pope made a motion to approve the above zoning change, with Larry Prestwood seconding. Vote unanimous.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Tim Sanders, council moved to change specs on the new street truck, and to re-advertise for bids to be opened on April 20, for an all wheel drive with snow plow, for use of pushing snow if needed.

Max Andrews made a motion, seconded by Dennis Wilson, to amend the budget by appropriating \$25,000.00 in a Recreation Fund, for the lightening of both ball fields, both bathrooms and concession stand. Vote unanimous.

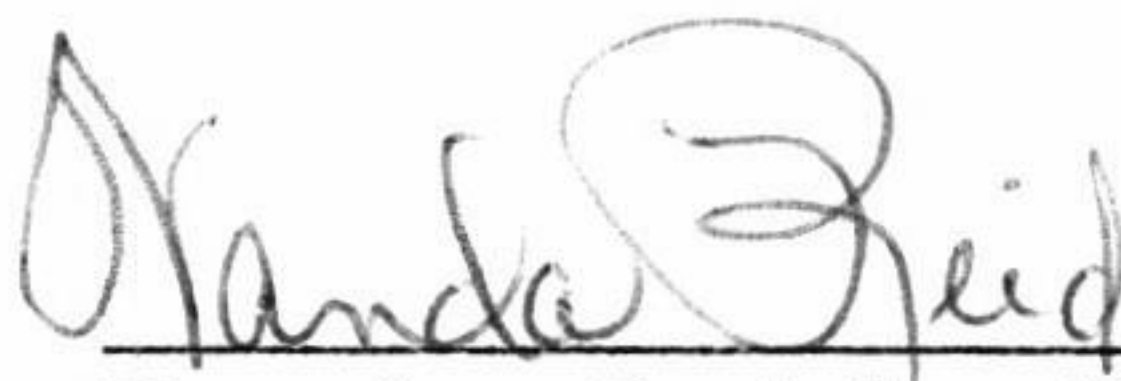
After a discussion, taking into consideration quality, performance and time specific, a motion made by Larry Prestwood, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to award Western Carolina the bid for electrical supplies and fifty eight lights for a total of \$18,384.91. Contractor shall be directed to submit proof of insurance as required by the Town Code.

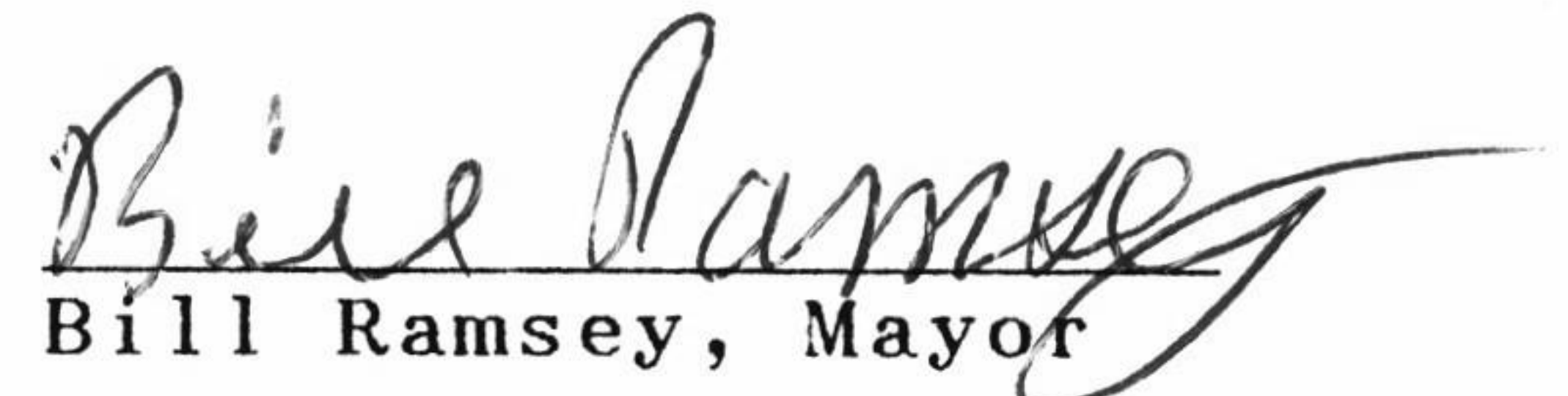
