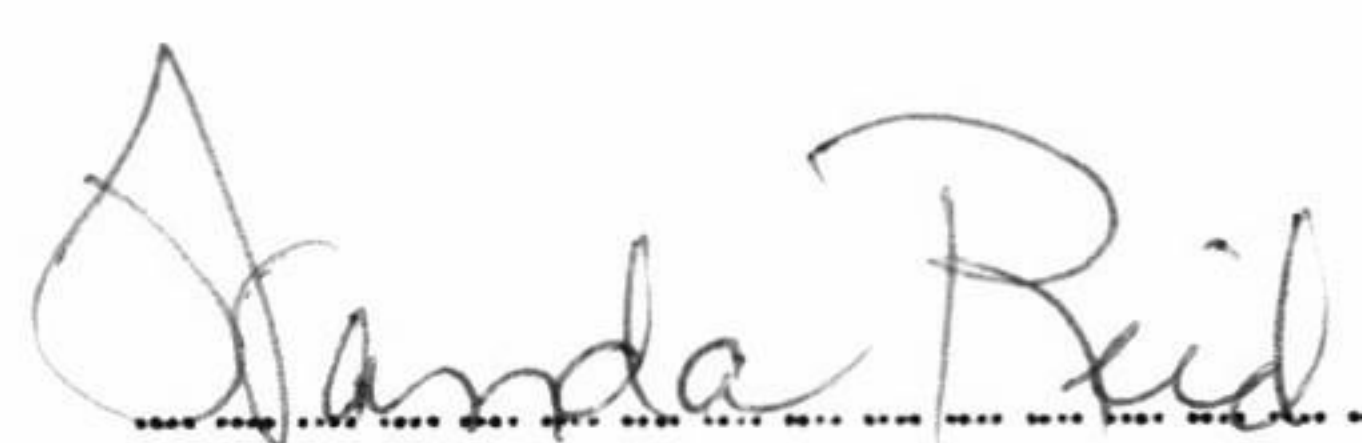

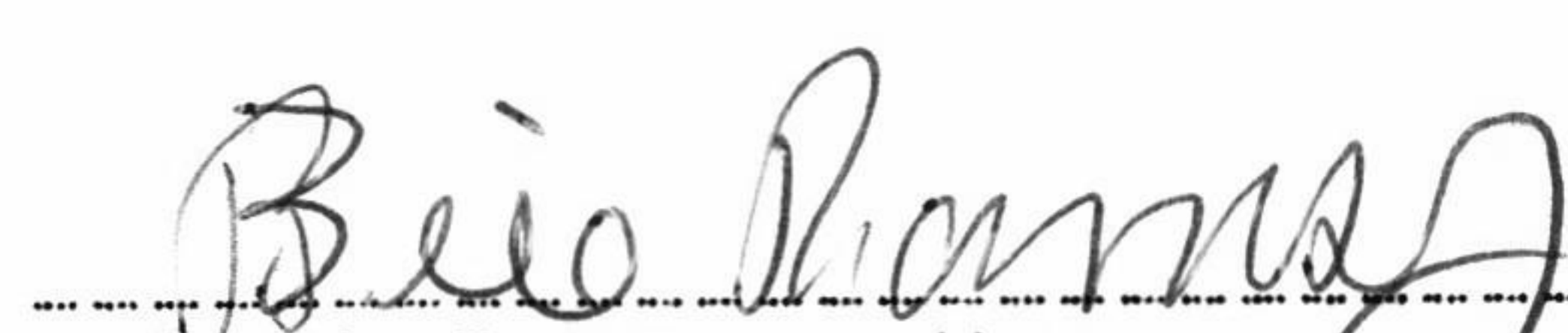
Motion was made by Eddie Wilson to have Randy Laws put the payroll records on computer, seconded by CJ Baker. All were in favor.
