

MINUTES

April 4, 1995

All council members were present as Mayor Max Andrews called the meeting to order. They were; Max Andrews, Dennis Wilson, Reva Tunmire, Paul Pope, Larry Prestwood and Jim Drum. Present also were; Billie Black, with Western Piedmont Council of Governments, Terry Taylor Attorney, Eric Davis Business Manager and Wanda Reid Town Clerk.

Invocation was given by Dennis Wilson.

The agenda was adopted with no changes.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council voted to approve the minutes of the March 21, 1995 meeting.

Dennis Wilson made the motion to approve the minutes of the special meeting, March 27, 1995. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Dennis Wilson, seconded by Reva Tunmire, council voted to approve paying the regular bills and the bill to KCM Office Supplies in the amount of \$97.17.

Billie Black, Community Development Administrator, for the Town of Sawmills HOME Program, recommended to council two applicants for housing rehabilitation. With approval and completion of these two units, the total number of housing units treated with HOME funds will be ten, which was the number proposed in the original application.

Paul Pope made the motion to approve the two applicants recommended by Ms. Black. Dennis Wilson seconded. Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Jim Drum and Larry Prestwood voted for. Reva Tunmire abstained.

On a motion made by Larry Prestwood, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council voted to call a public hearing for April 18, 1995 at 7:00 pm town hall, to close out the Community Development Block Grant.

Business Manager Eric Davis related to council of Crown Cables decision to change their name to "Charter Communications." The change pertains to their name only and does not constitute a change in the ownership of the system. This change will become effective April 1995.

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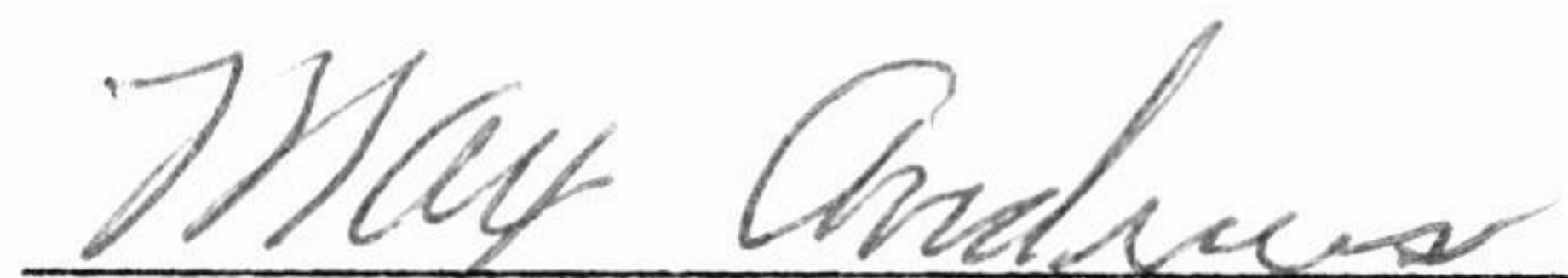
Mr. Davis informed council that he, Mayor Max Andrews and Town Engineer Chester West had met in Raleigh earlier Tuesday morning on the town's application for a loan for sewer system installation. It was noted that state officials looked favorably on the project.

Eric Davis communicated to council of a letter from County Manager David Flaherty notifying them that the county is considering implementing residential landfill tipping fees of \$35.00 per ton effective July 1, 1995. It is estimated the new fee would cost Sawmills around \$90,000. per year.

At 7:20 pm, on a motion made by Larry Prestwood, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council voted unanimously to adjourn.

MINUTES OF BUDGET MEETING
April 04, 1995, 6:00 PM at Town Hall

All council members were present as Mayor Max Andrews called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. They were: Dennis Wilson, Reva Tunmire, Paul Pope, Larry Prestwood, and Jim Drum. Invocation was given by Randy Laws.

Business Manager, Eric Davis, started out by pointing out to an excessive amount of money in checking accounts and asking for permission to transfer some of it into cd's. Approval was given.

Next the revenue amounts were given and explained with no questions coming from anyone. Expenditure line items were then presented by department with emphasis on the lately announced landfill charges by the county. After some discussion it was decided to wait and see if the charges would actually be in place before deciding what to do about where the funds were going to come from.

The hiring of another full time administrative person was then brought up by Davis with no questions from the board.

At 9:05 pm Reva Tunmire made the motion to adjourn with Paul Pope seconding. The vote to adjourn was unanimous.
