APRIL 6 1993-5:00 PM AT TOWN HALL

Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Larry Prestwood, Dennis Wilson, and Tim Sanders were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the regular meeting to order.

Invocation was given by Rev. Fred Hicks.

Paving bids on resurfacing roads was added to Old Business. f., Executive Session to discuss legal advise was added to New Business. Tim Sanders moved to adopt the agenda, with changes, with Larry Prestwood seconding. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to approve the minutes of March 16, 1993.

Larry Prestwood made a motion to pay the bills. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to award Asphalt Care & Paving Inc. the low bidder, the contract for the amount for each of the above streets.

Matt Thompson, with the Safety and Health Council of North Carolina, related to the board of the benefits of joining his company. The Safety and Health Council works with the NC Department of Labor and the League of Municipalities in complying with the OSHA standards that municipalities now have to conform to. Tim Sanders made a motion to join the Safety and Health Council of North Carolina for \$180.00 annually, and to appoint Ronnie Coffey, employee, as Safety Officer for the Town of Sawmills. Dennis Wilson seconded with all in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to authorize Rick Oxford, with Western Piedmont Council of Governments to apply for a \$150,000.00 grant with the HOME program, with Sawmills paying a \$9,370.00 match. Unlike the CDBG grant which allows only a predetermined section of homes needing rehabilitation in Sawmills, the HOME grant will permit the board to chose owner occupied houses, or trailers all over Sawmills for rehabilitation.

Dennis Wilson made a motion to let Arnold Arrowood purchase new tires for a garbage truck and the town's service truck that he drives. Paul Pope seconded, with all in favor.

On a motion made by Dennis Wilson, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to adopt a Bloodborn Pathogens Policy for the Town of Sawmills.

Larry Prestwood made a motion, seconded by Paul Pope, that council request Mike Legg, Town Planner, to check into a complaint of a basketball goal placed in right-of-way of a town street that allows children to play in the road. All were in favor.

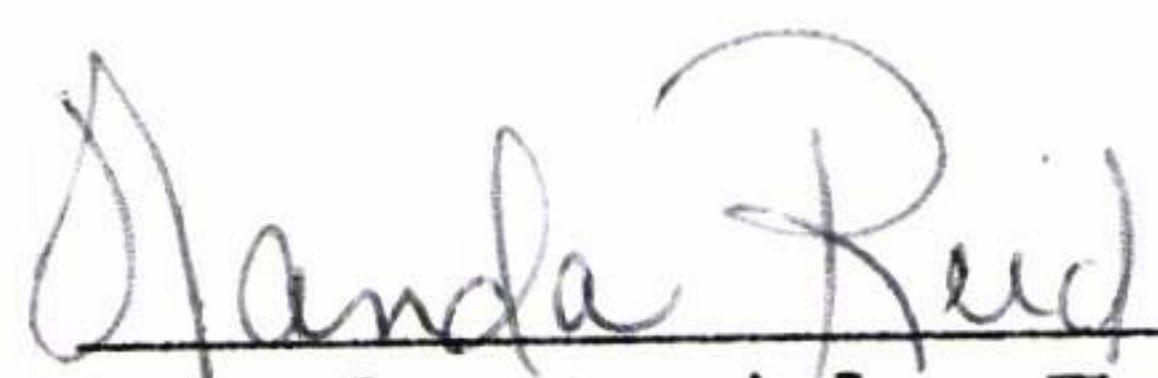

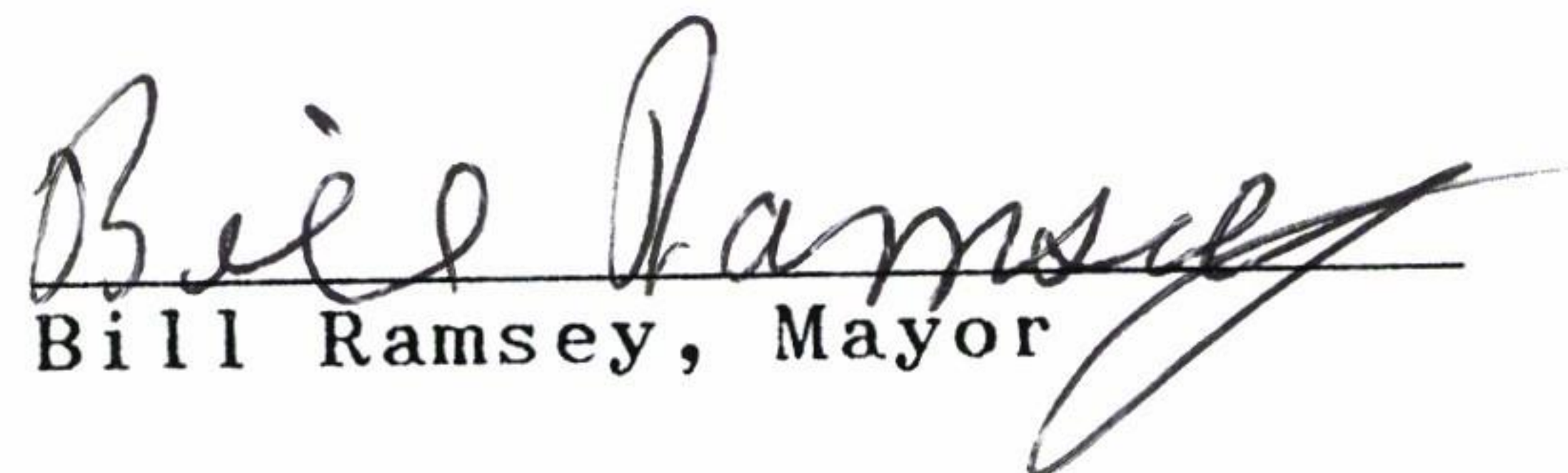
Larry Prestwood moved that the town purchase another round of neon stick pens (buy 500, get 500 free). Dennis Wilson seconded. All in favor.
