

TOWN OF SAWMILLS  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
APRIL 14, 1992

Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Larry Prestwood, Dennis Wilson, and Tim Sanders were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order.

Rev. Fred Hicks gave the invocation.

Dennis Wilson made a motion to adopt the agenda. Larry Prestwood seconded, with all in favor.

Tim Sanders made a motion to accept the minutes of the previous meeting. All were in favor as Larry Prestwood seconded.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Max Andrews, council moved to appoint Larry Prestwood as Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) representative as requested by Western Piedmont Council of Governments.

Charles Beck with Blue Ridge Electric appeared before the board stating that several of the Virginia Acres residents were requesting street lights to be placed on their lots in Virginia Acres. He related that there were 106 homes in Virginia Acres. Mr Beck stated that residences could get quite a savings on their light bills if the town could be billed for the street lights, then in turn, bill the residences on their water bills. Several people attended the meeting and there was quite a discussion. No decision was made at this time.

The state of North Carolina has required all medium size public water systems to monitor for lead and copper beginning July 1, 1992. Tim Sanders made a motion to accept Bio-Chem Laboratory offer to do the field testing at \$12.50 a site, not to exceed \$15.00 for each test. Max Andrews seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to get a bulk mail permit for the mailing of the brochures on the recycling.

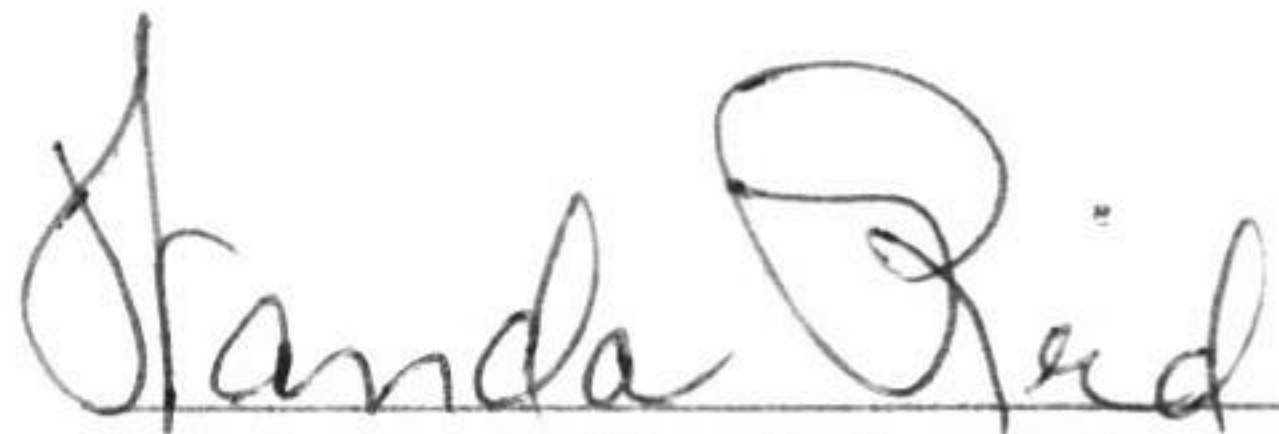
Dennis Wilson made a motion to have another planning session on April 25, 1992 at Country Inn at 8:00 am. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

Dennis Wilson related to the other board members that a Recycling Program has been planned for Sawmills Elementary school beginning May 8, and running through May 25, 1992. This would educate the children and their parents about the need to recycle. He

asked the board to designate the month of May as "Recycling Month." He stated that the children would be asked to come up with a logo that can be used on the recycling truck. A \$50.00 savings bond would be presented for the best logo. The presentation will be at town hall on May 25, 1992 at 5:00 pm. Judges for this event will be: Bill Ramsey, Mayor of Sawmills, Rick Crouse, Pastor of Dry Ponds Union Church, Roger Brookshire, Fire Chief of the Sawmills Fire Department, Joel Carrol, Principal of Hudson Elementary School, Glenn Walker, Pastor of Mt. Zion Baptist Church, and Wanda Reid, Town Clerk.

Dennis Wilson related that he had represented the Town of Sawmills on the Caldwell County Solid Waste Advice Committee for several years, and would like to resign. He requested that another council member be appointed to this board. No decision was made at this time.

At 6:25 pm, Larry Prestwood made a motion to adjourn. Dennis Wilson seconded. All were in favor.
