Minutes of the last minutes was approved.

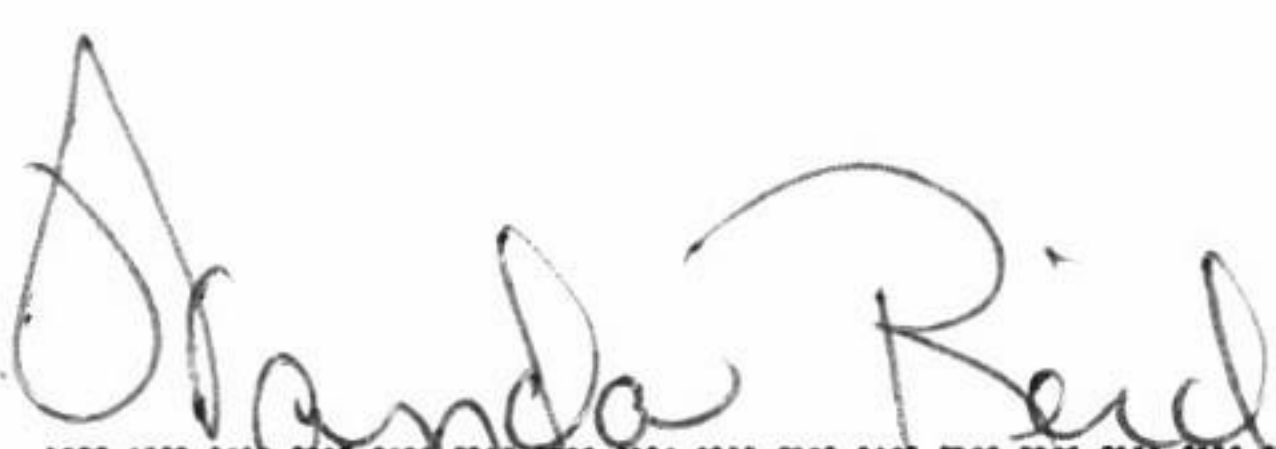

The Christmas decorations and flags were tabled until the next meeting.

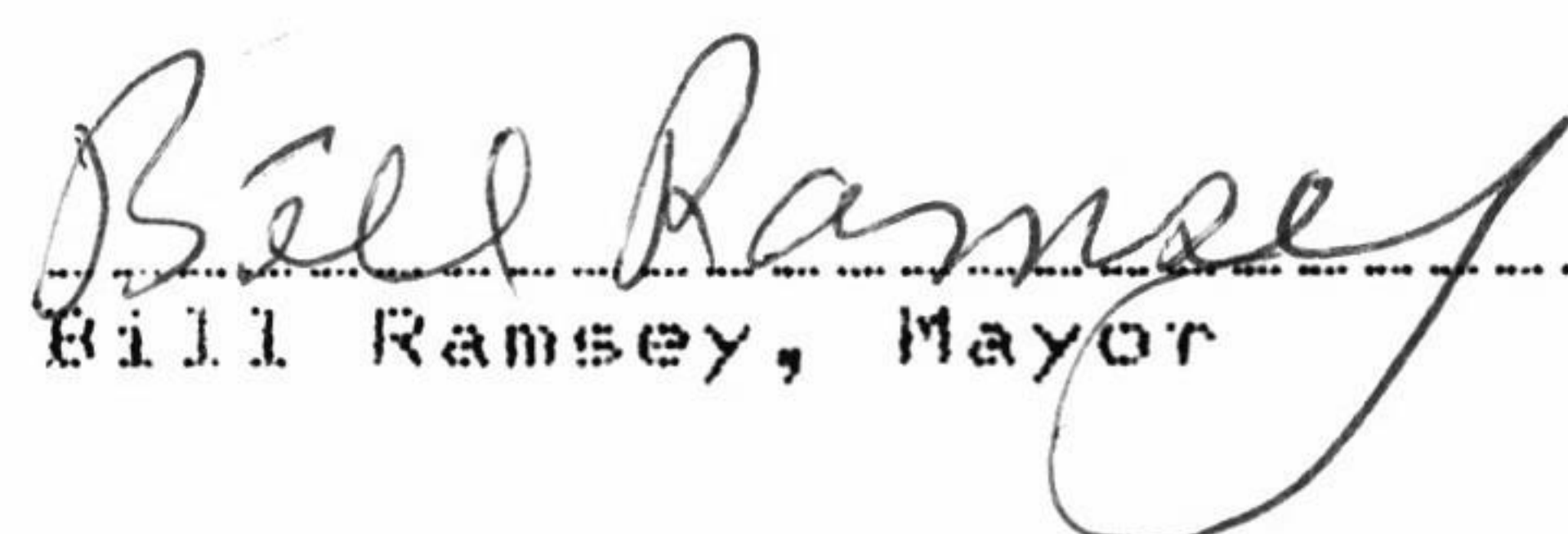
After some discussion the board asked Arnold Arrowood to prepare bid specifications and secure an estimated price by the next meeting for a back hoe.
