CALL TO ORDER—David Stamey, Mayor, called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.

INVOCATION---Joe Helton gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE---Mayor David Stamey led the audience in the saying of the pledge of allegiance.

ADOPT AGENDA---Robert Frye, Town Administrator requested that item 10-c Resolution Requesting Municipal Revenue Sources Be Made Secure, be added to the agenda. Joe Helton made a motion to adopt the agenda. The motion was seconded by Gerelene Blevins. All were in favor.

APPROVAL OF APRIL 16, 2002, REGULAR MEETING MINUTES AND APRIL 23, 2002 SPECIAL BUDGET MEETING---Gerelene Blevins made motion to approve if minutes were changed to include the correct spelling of her name. Pat Harrison seconded. All were in favor.

APPRECIATION LETTER FOR MELODY WILSON---Gerelene Blevins made a motion to present Ms. Wilson with a letter of appreciation. Mayor Stamey suggested proclaiming May 11, 2002 as Melody Wilson Day. Joe Norman made the motion, with Gerelene Blevins seconding. All were in favor.

CDBG SEWER PROJECT---Mr. Frye informed Council that remaining easements were to be signed next week and that the project was in the permit review stage. In order to save time, Mr. Frye requested Council allow the Town engineer to bid the project now.

Mr. Stamey suggested that contractors should make the landowners aware that there will be construction on their property. Joe Norman made the motion, with Gerelene seconding. All were in favor.

HAROLD BOWMAN DRAINAGE SITUATION---Mr. Frye reported that the majority of Mr. Bowman's drainage problem was the result of run off from two of his drains. Mr. Frye suggested that replacing the drainage ditch that Mr. Bowman removed might help but Mr. Bowman would have to redirect his drains to solve most of the problem. Mr. Bowman was not in attendance to respond.

DOG SITUATION—Mr. Frye reminded Council that, as discussed in the last budget meeting, there are not sufficient funds to hire an enforcement officer, but that adequate funds would be included in the budget to purchase three cages for this problem.

FIRST TIME HOME BUYERS SEMINAR—Mayor Stamey reminded everyone about this event to be held at the Town Hall on Tuesday May 14th at 6:00.

WILLA DEAN STORY/ROY HALL ZONING COMPLAINTS---Ms. Story nor Mr. Hall were not in attendance and their complaints were not discussed.

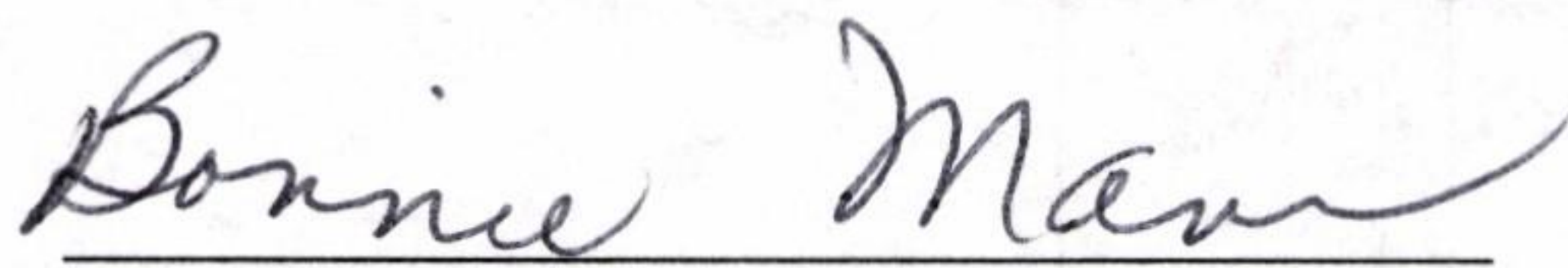
RESOLUTION REQUESTING MUNICIPAL REVENUE SOURCES BE SECURED-

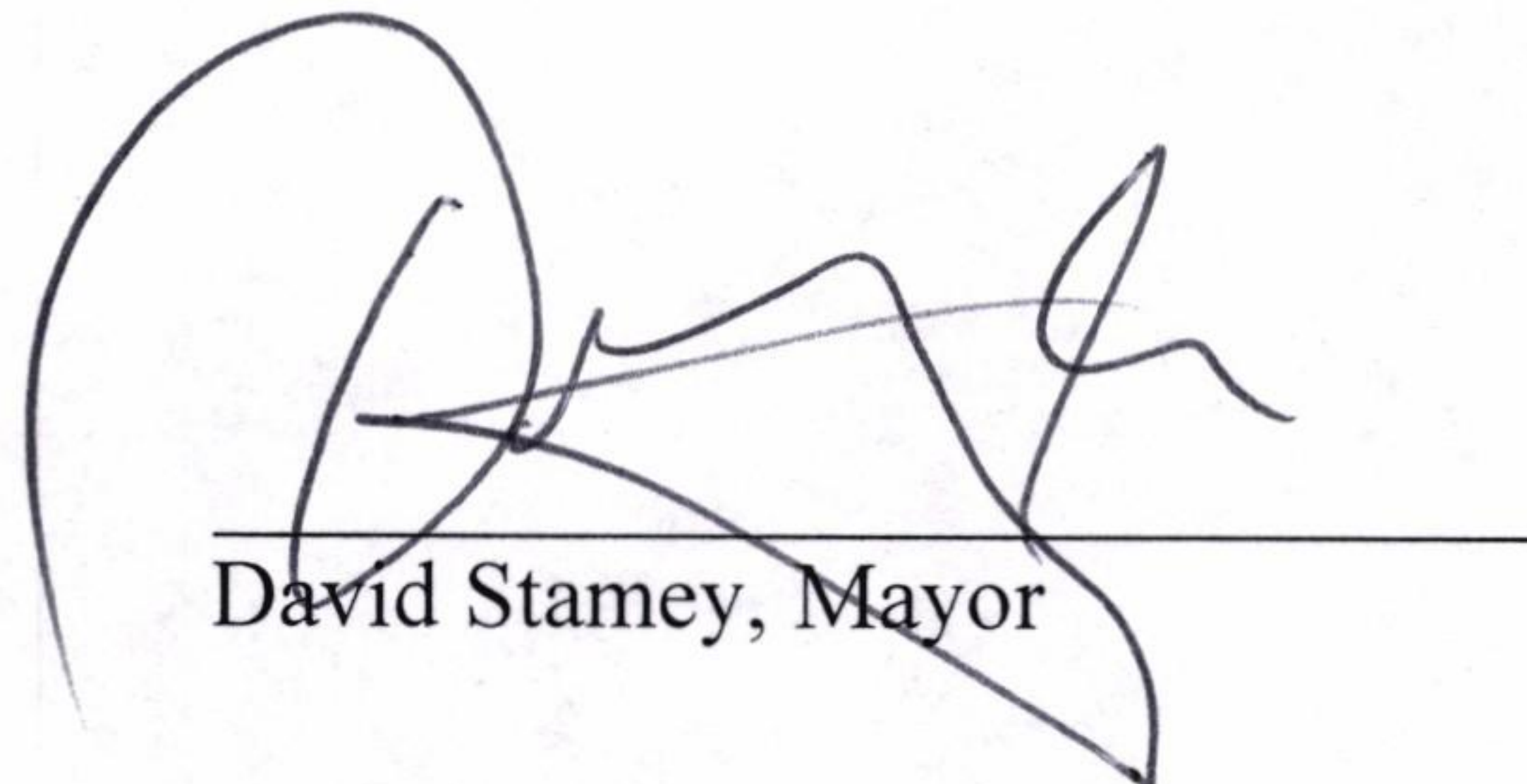
