Minutes of Meeting
May 8, 1990, 5:00 PM at
town hall

All members of the board was present for the regular meeting. They were Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Maxine Stamey, CJ Baker, Paul Pope and Eddie Wilson.

Rev. Willard Jenkins gave the invocation.

The minutes of the last meeting were approved. Paul Pope made the motion to pay all outstanding bills, seconded by CJ Baker. All were in favor.

Maxine Stamey made the motion that the town purchase 50, 3'X 5' American flags at the cost of \$12.00 each. Motion was seconded by Eddie Wilson. All were in favor. The purchase of Christmas decorations was tabled.

Motion was made by Max Andrews that the towns lawyer, Terry Taylor contact the State Board of Election about the possibility of Sawmills conducting its own municipal election. Seconding this motion was Paul Pope. All were in favor except Eddie Wilson, saying, "If we have to go to two different places to vote, I'm against it."

After some discussion, CJ Baker made the motion to call for bids of a back hoe with cab, to be opened at the regular meeting of June 12, 1990. Maxine Stamey seconded with all in favor.

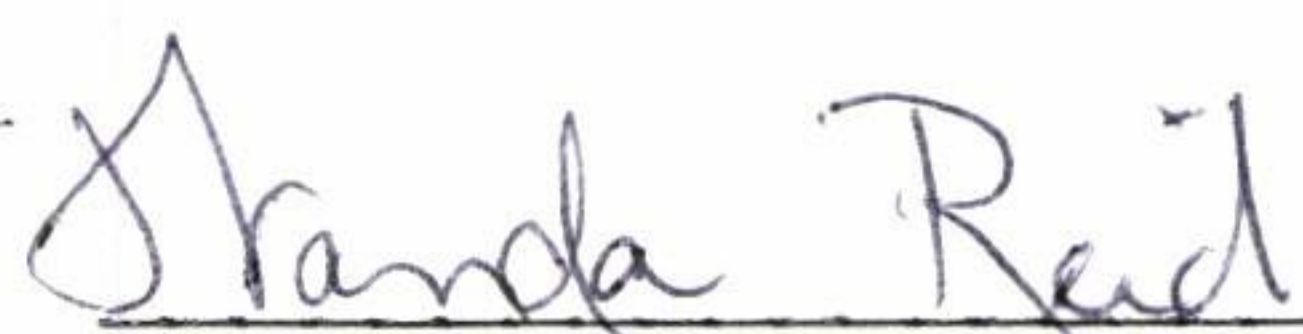
CJ Baker made the motion to approve an exemption from the town zoning moratorium to permit Jack Caldwell to add a new roof to his Rhodhiss Furniture to replace a leaking roof that threatens to damage the building and its contents. This is a repair to existing property, and is not a new structure. Maxine Stamey seconded this motion with all in favor.

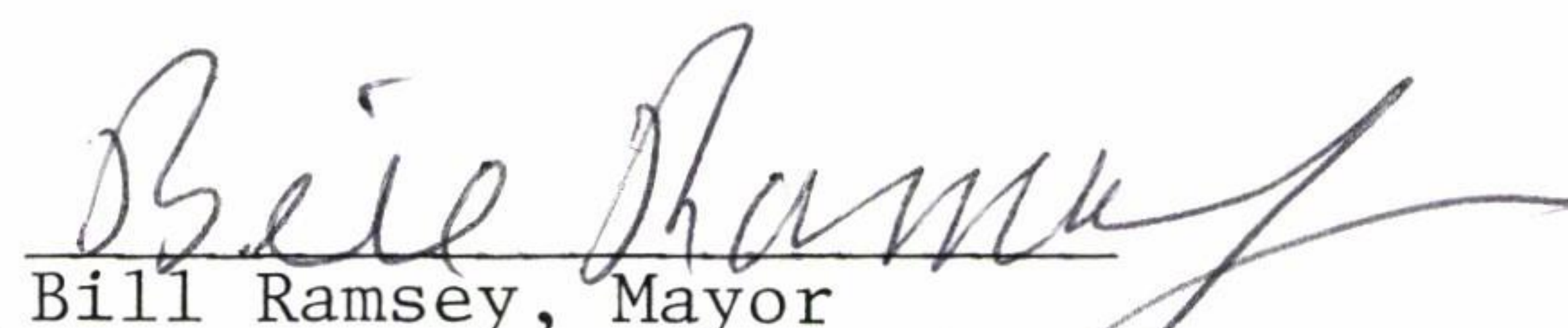
Motion was made by CJ Baker to name an unnamed street beside his home in Villa Woods, Villa Lane. Eddie Wilson seconded. All were in favor.
