

TOWN OF SAWMILLS MINUTES
MAY 18, 1993
5:00 P.M.

Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order with all councilmen present. They were; Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood, and Tim Sanders.

Invocation was given by Rev. Glenn Walker.

Tim Sanders made a motion to adopt the agenda after adding b., park, to New Business. Larry Prestwood seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to approve the minutes of May 4, 1993.

Motion was made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Paul Pope to pay all outstanding bills. Motion was unanimous.

Charles Priddy, President of the Sawmills Optimist Club related to council of the services the optimist club would be willing to perform at the Sawmills Town Park.

Paul Pope made a motion that the town purchase a Woods mower at the cost of \$1,450.00 to be used on the old tractor for mowing the park. Dennis Wilson seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Max Andrews, seconded by Tim Sanders, council moved to give the old tractor to the Sawmills Optimist Club.

Paul Pope moved that council accept the following services of the Sawmills Optimist Club for the upkeep of the town's park. Tim Sanders seconded with all in favor.

1. Organize and run all youth athletic events and supervise any other athletic events that may be scheduled.
2. Maintain the appearance of the park, such as cutting the grass and picking up litter, and pay electric bills for ballfield lights.
3. Provide labor for the upkeep of the press boxes and concession stand.
4. Provide labor for the upkeep of the two baseball fields and any other items that may be installed at the park for youth activities.

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After some discussion, council decided to table the adoption of the amendment to the Town of Sawmills Town Vehicle Assignment Use and Cost Reimbursement Policy and Procedures until the next meeting in order to study it further. The town clerk was directed to post a copy of this policy and amendment on the bulletin board for employees of the town to also study.

Since the town has been recycling, the town has been paying \$108.00 a month to lease a trailer for use in storing the plastic. On a motion made by Dennis Wilson, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to purchase a trailer for this use at the cost of \$1,800.00. Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood and Tim Sanders voted for and Max Andrews voted against.

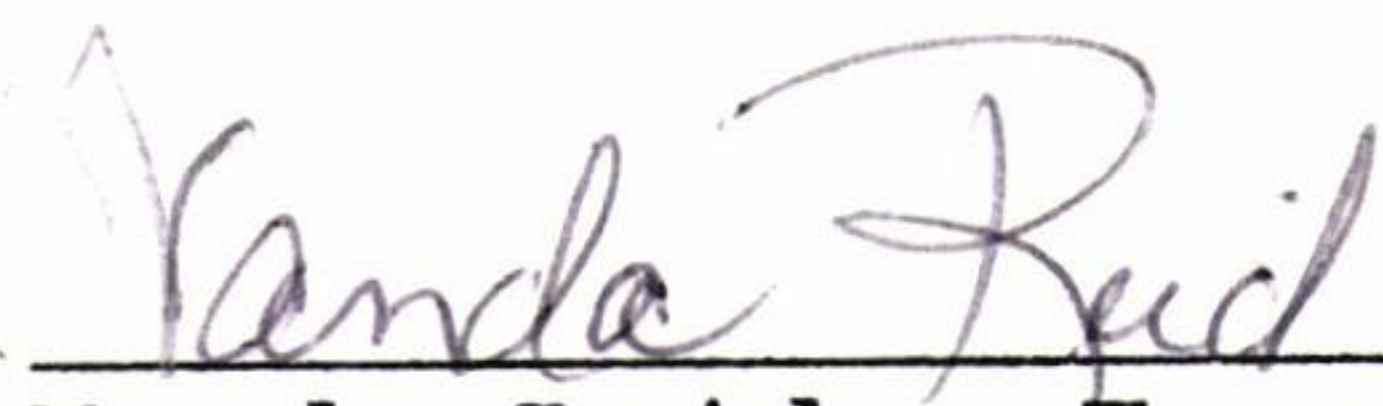
Mike Legg, Sawmills Town Planner, related to council that the Planning Board had checked into the voluntary annexation previously requested from residents off the Cajah's Mountain Road, and the Planning Board favored the voluntary annexation. Water lines are already in place along Cajah's Mountain Road in that area. On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved that the town planner contact the original petitioners by letter and inform them that they need to work on 100% of the residents to sign the petition for voluntary annexation.

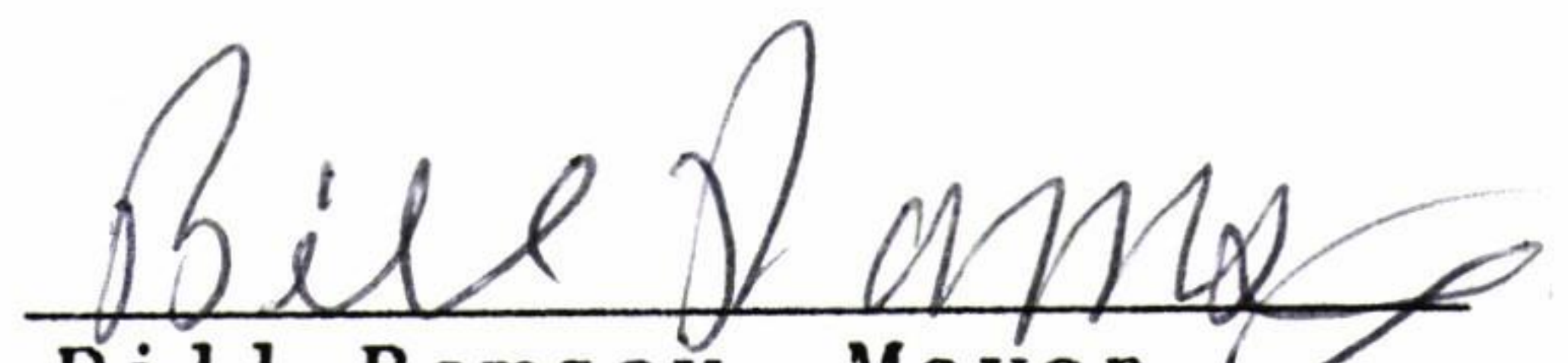
A request was made for voluntary annexation of Glennbrook Development on Greystone Avenue, off the Horseshoe Bend Road. There is no water line close to this development. The Towns Water Extension Policy states that the extension of a water line shall be entirely at the expense of the person or persons desiring to make this installation. It would cost the town approximately \$14,526.00 to install water lines to this development. On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to direct the planning board to further study estimated costs for this project and to report back to the board.

It was noted that Town Hall Day would be held in Raleigh, on May 25, 1993 and that two members of the board would attend.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to have a budget meeting on Monday, May 24, 1993 at 7:30 pm.

Dennis Wilson made a motion to adjourn at 6:20 pm. Max Andrews seconded. All were in favor.
