Max Andrews made the motion to call for a public hearing on the budget June 12, 1990 at 5:00 PM at town hall. Maxine Stamey seconded with all in favor.

Maxine Stamey made the motion that Randy Laws work the necessary hours as needed through the end of June, then be considered for full time employment in July. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.
