

TOWN OF SAWMILLS
MINUTES OF MEETING
MAY 26, 1992-TOWN HALL

All members were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. They were: Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood, and Tim Sanders.

Invocation was given by Mayor Pro-tem Max Andrews.

Tim Sanders made a motion to adopt the agenda with the addition of Terry Edwards and Mr and Mrs Clinard Bowman. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

A correction to the previous minutes was made. A motion was made to post 25 mph speed limit signs throughout Virginia Acres, instead of 35 mph on the outside streets and 25 mph on all other streets.

Max Andrews made a motion to accept the minutes. Paul Pope seconded.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to hire Steve Gary Coonse at \$5.50 an hour to work on the garbage truck and any other work needed done.

Tony Gragg with Bio-Chem Laboratories related to the board of a state-mandated testing for copper and lead levels of plumbing in residences built between January 1, 1983 and December 31, 1987. This testing will be done between July 1, 1992 and January 31, 1993. Since the Town of Sawmills has 4088 in population, 40 single family homes will have to be tested for levels of lead and copper in their water.

Terry Edwards, member of the Sawmills Christmas Committee, related to the council that the committee had got a late start soliciting donations for Christmas funds. Terry requested that the town purchase the Christmas lights because the deadline of a 35% sale ends on May 27, 1992. On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to purchase Christmas lights at the cost of \$2,143.48.

Residents of Blackburn Court, Mr and Mrs Clinard Bowman, requested that something be done about stray dogs in the neighborhood, running at large, and turning over garbage cans. Council directed the town clerk to send a letter to the dogs owners requesting them to take care of this matter.

Paul Pope made a motion to allow Asphalt Care & Paving to pull ditches on Jay Street, Amber Drive, Marcus Drive, and Holden Place, at the cost of \$45.00 per hour for motor grader, \$40.00 an hour

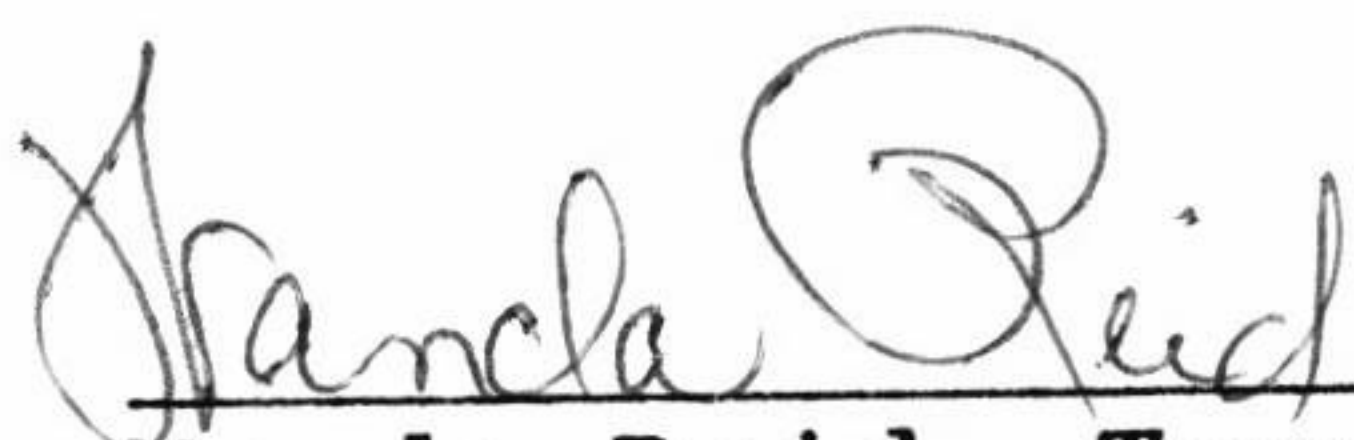
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back hoe, and \$35.00 an hour to use truck. Larry Prestwood seconded. All were in favor.

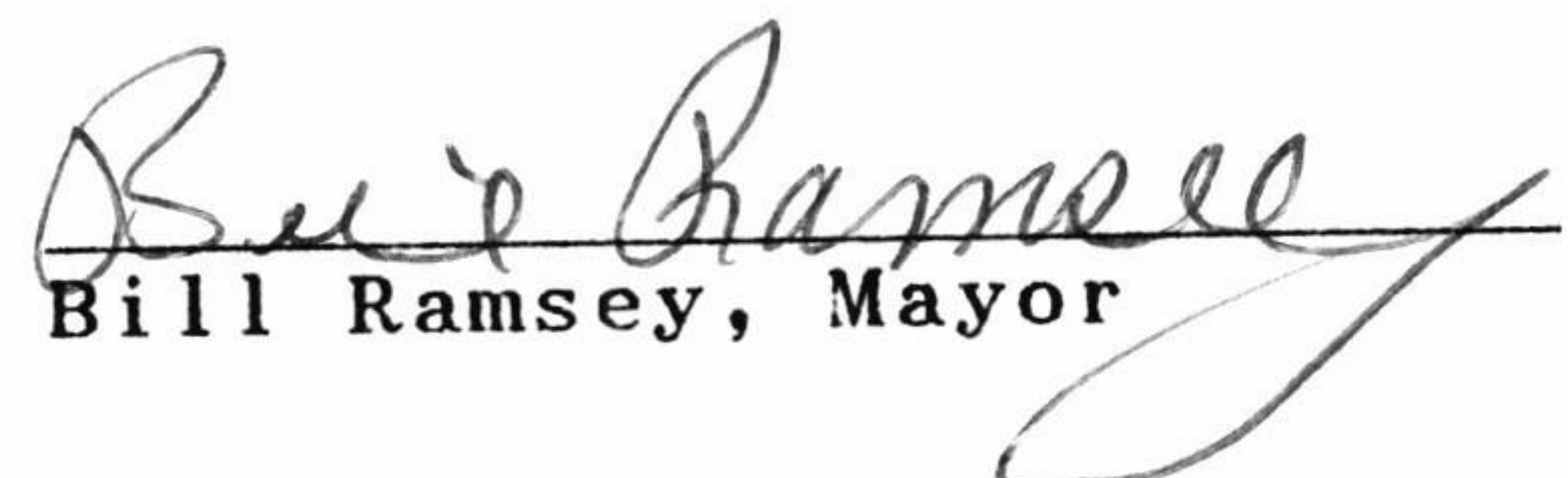

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to place a \$75.00 advertisement in the Caldwell News congratulating this years high school graduates.

Dennis Wilson made a motion to prepare another news letter to residents of the town about recycling, to be given out with the bins are delivered, and to allow Computer Forms, Inc. to print the brochures. Motion was seconded by Larry Prestwood. All were in favor.

At 6:09 PM, Dennis Wilson made a motion to adjourn. Max Andrews seconded. All were in favor.
