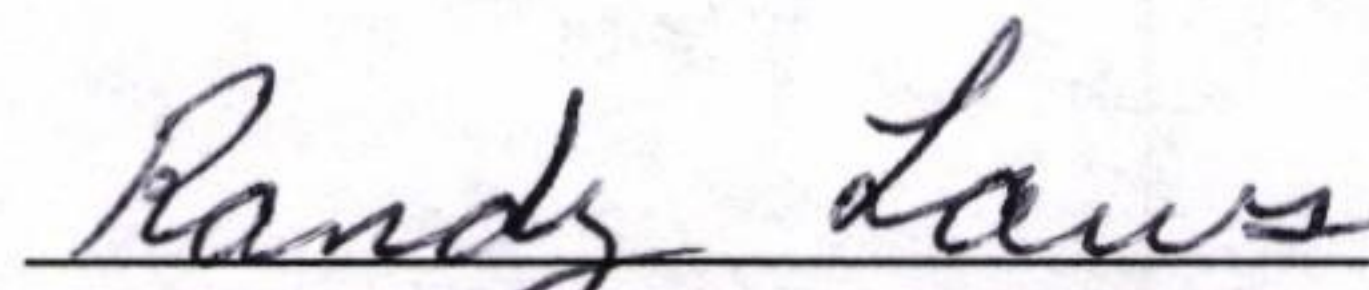

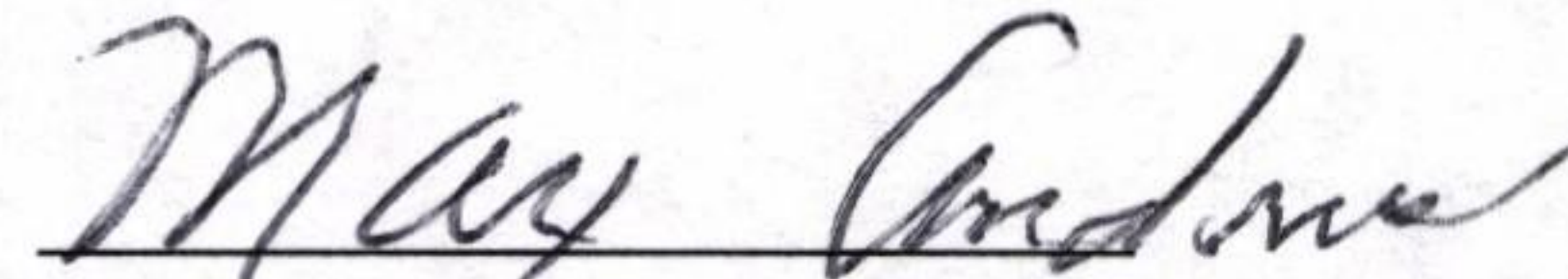
Reva Tunmire gave the invocation.

Mayor Andrews then called for comments from the floor. Several residents spoke for and against the need to extend the period.

Dennis Wilson gave the invocation.

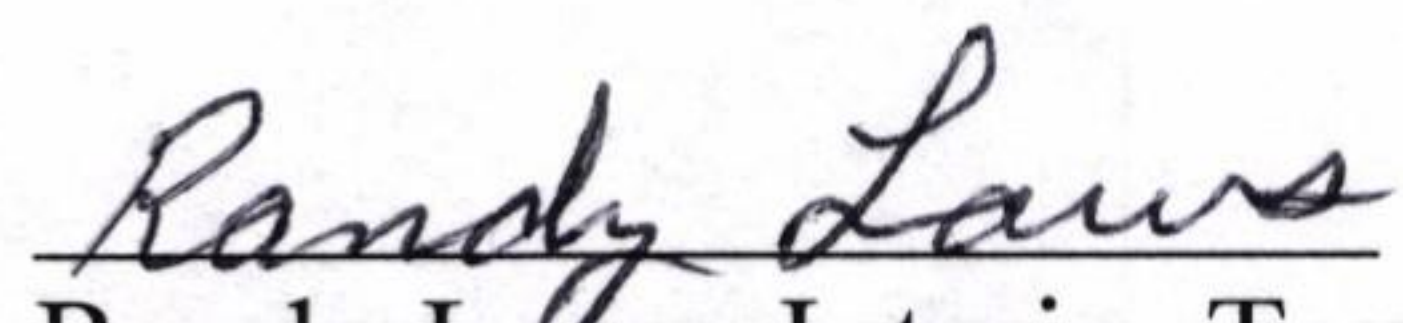
Business Manager Eric Davis reminded the council of the action taken to bring the three lowest paid employees wages up to seven dollars and twenty five cents per hour.

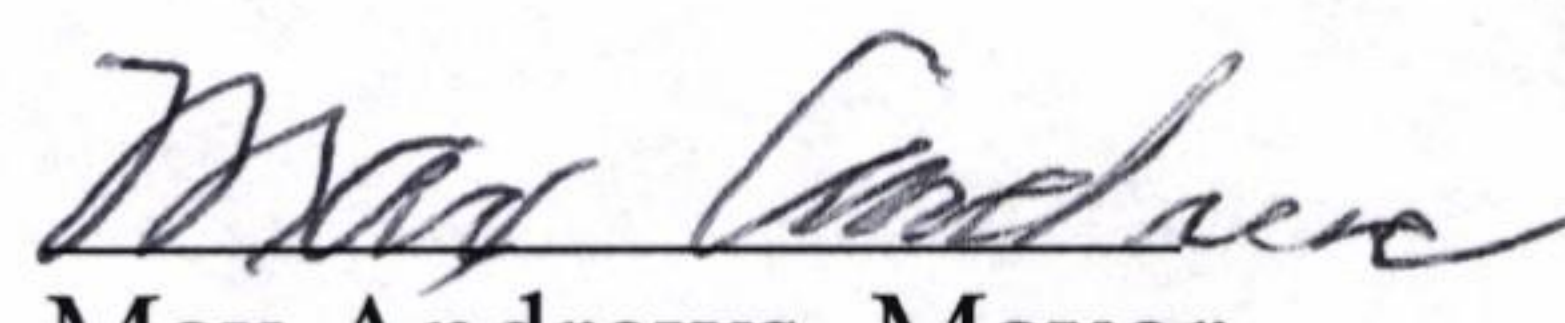
Councilman Jim Drum expressed a desire to give a 2.5 percent increase to those employees who received only a cost of living increase of 2 percent. A discussion followed and no further action was taken on that matter.

Larry Prestwood made a motion to leave all wages as they were and begin doing quarterly evaluations starting October 1995. Reva Tunmire seconded and all were in favor.

Eric Davis was then instructed to contact the MAPS Group about bonuses.

At 12:45 Larry Prestwood made the motion to adjourn. Reva Tunmire seconded and all were in favor.
