

TOWN OF SAWMILLS
MINUTES OF MEETING
AUGUST 27, 1991 AT TOWN HALL

Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order with all council members present. They were, Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Eddie Wilson, and Dare Duncan.

Invocation was given by Mayor Pro-tem, Max Andrews.

The minutes of the last meeting was approved as distributed.

After discussing the tipping fee that Caldwell County has levied on municipalities in the county, the council deemed it necessary to charge the business in the town a fee each week on their garbage pick up in order to recover some of the fees charged to the town by the county. These business have two pick-ups a week. On a motion made by Eddie Wilson, seconded by Max Andrews, council moved to charge homeowners outside the towns limit six dollars per month for garbage pick-up. Paul Pope made the motion to charge Industrial Seaming, which generates two tons a week, thirty-six dollars a week, five medium sized businesses will be charged ten dollars per week, and twenty two smaller businesses, five dollars per week. Eddie Wilson, seconded, with all in favor. The Town clerk will mail letters to each business explaining this motion that will become effective September 1, 1991.

Max Andrews made the motion to accept an easement for two hundred dollars from Junior Townsend on a 20 foot drive way going into property that the town wishes to purchase for a possible water tank site. Paul Pope seconded with all in favor.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dare Duncan, council moved to accept an option on a half-acre lot off Leah Drive for five thousand dollars.

Dare Duncan made the motion to approve Eastern Engineering and Testing Co. as the soil testing firm. Max Andrews seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Eddie Wilson, council moved to spend as much as two thousand, four hundred forty dollars on the soil testing.

The Christmas Parade was tabled until the next meeting.

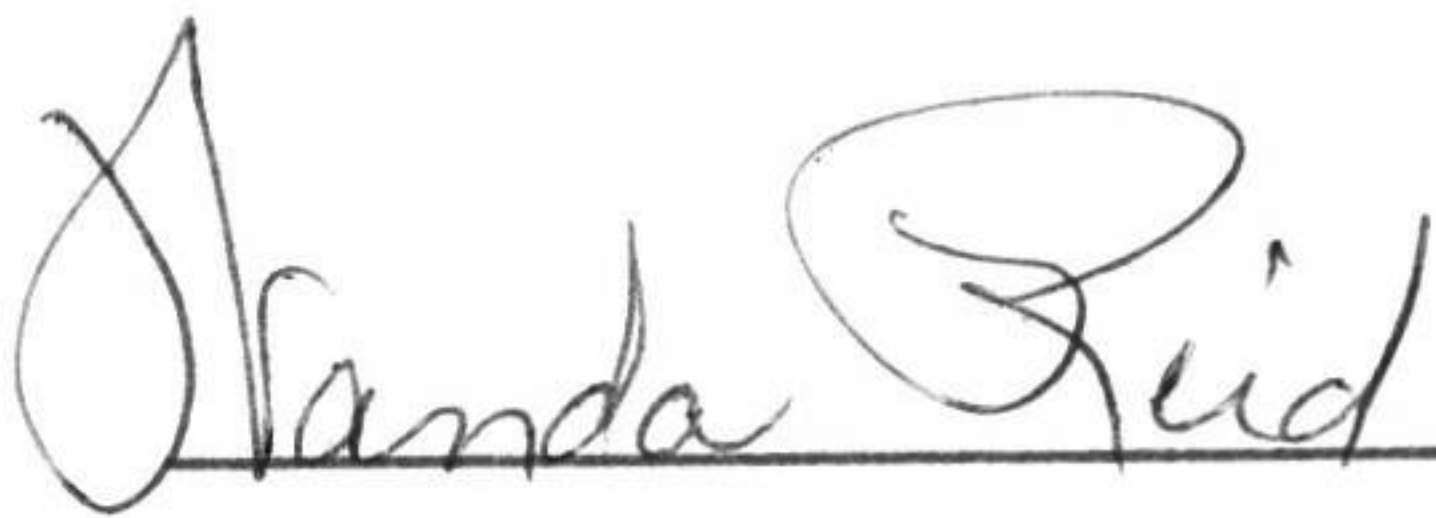
Paul Pope made the motion to let Keith White purchase the wire, and needed materials and do the work on the wiring of the poles for the Christmas Decorations. The town would then reimburse him for his work and materials bought. Dare Duncan seconded. All were in favor.

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On a motion made by Dare Duncan, seconded by Eddie Wilson, council moved that plaques be presented to ex-councilman CJ Baker, and ex-council woman Maxine Stamey commending them for their outstanding contributions to the Town of Sawmills during their many years of service. The plaques are to be given to them during the annual Christmas Dinner.

Eddie Wilson made the motion to pass an ordinance from the state to extend the existing 35 mph speed limit on SR 1130 (Cajah Mountain Road) from 1.0 mile west of US 321-A to the western corporate limit of Sawmills. Paul Pope seconded, with all in favor.

At 6:03 PM, Dare Duncan made the motion to adjourn. Max Andrews seconded. All were in favor.
