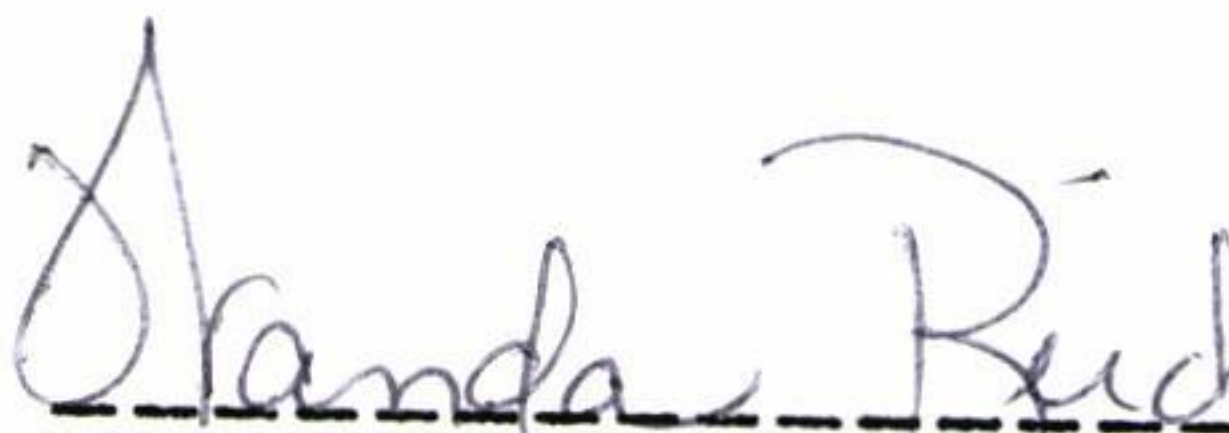
Eddie Wilson made the motion to have the Union Church Road graveled. Max Andrews seconded. All were in favor.

Arnold Arrowood advised the board that the new garbage truck would arrive August 31, 1990.

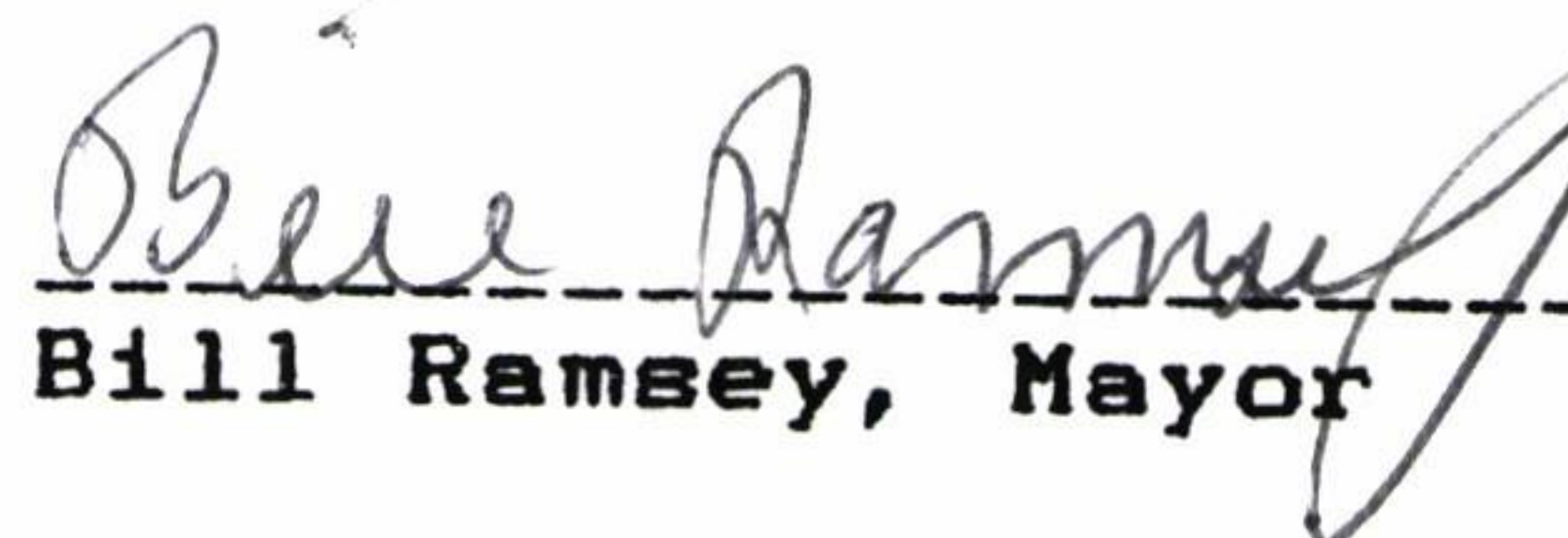
Max Andrews made the motion to purchase 24 water meters. Eddie Wilson seconded, with all in favor.
