MINUTES OF MEETING
SEPTEMBER 15, 1992
5:00 PM, at TOWN HALL

All members were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. They were: Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Larry Prestwood, Dennis Wilson, and Tim Sanders.

Rev. Rick Crouse gave the invocation.

A., Lenoir News Topic was deleted from the agenda. C., Christmas Lights, and D., Robert Russell with Finkbeiner, Pettis & Strout, Limited was added. Larry Prestwood made a motion to accept the changes of the agenda, Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Max Andrews, council moved to approve the minutes of August 31, 1992 and September 1, 1992.

Bids for the Walking Trail in the Optimist Park are as follows:

Larry Prestwood made a motion to contract with Asphalt Care & Paving to pave the walking trail at no more than \$5,010.00. Dennis Wilson seconded. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Larry Prestwood, seconded by Tim Sanders, council moved to call a special meeting on Friday, September 18, 1992 at 8:30 AM, to discuss proposals with Robert Russell of FPS and Chester West, of West & Associates, of needs for a sewer study.

Larry Prestwood made a motion to apply for a feasibility study with the state for the possible enrolling of town employees in the state retirement program. All were in favor as Tim Sanders seconded.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved that Larry Prestwood direct the Christmas Parade this year.

Tim Sanders related that some members of the board should attend an elective official workshop on accounting, financial reporting, and financial policies to be given at the Institute of Government on October 8, 1992.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to amend the budget for FY ending June 30, 1993 as follows.

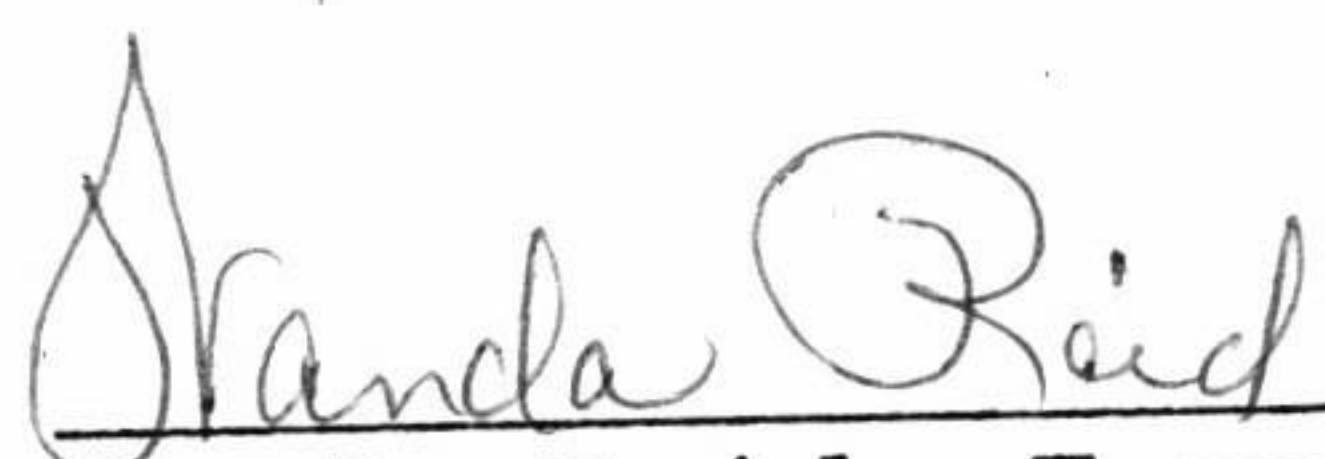

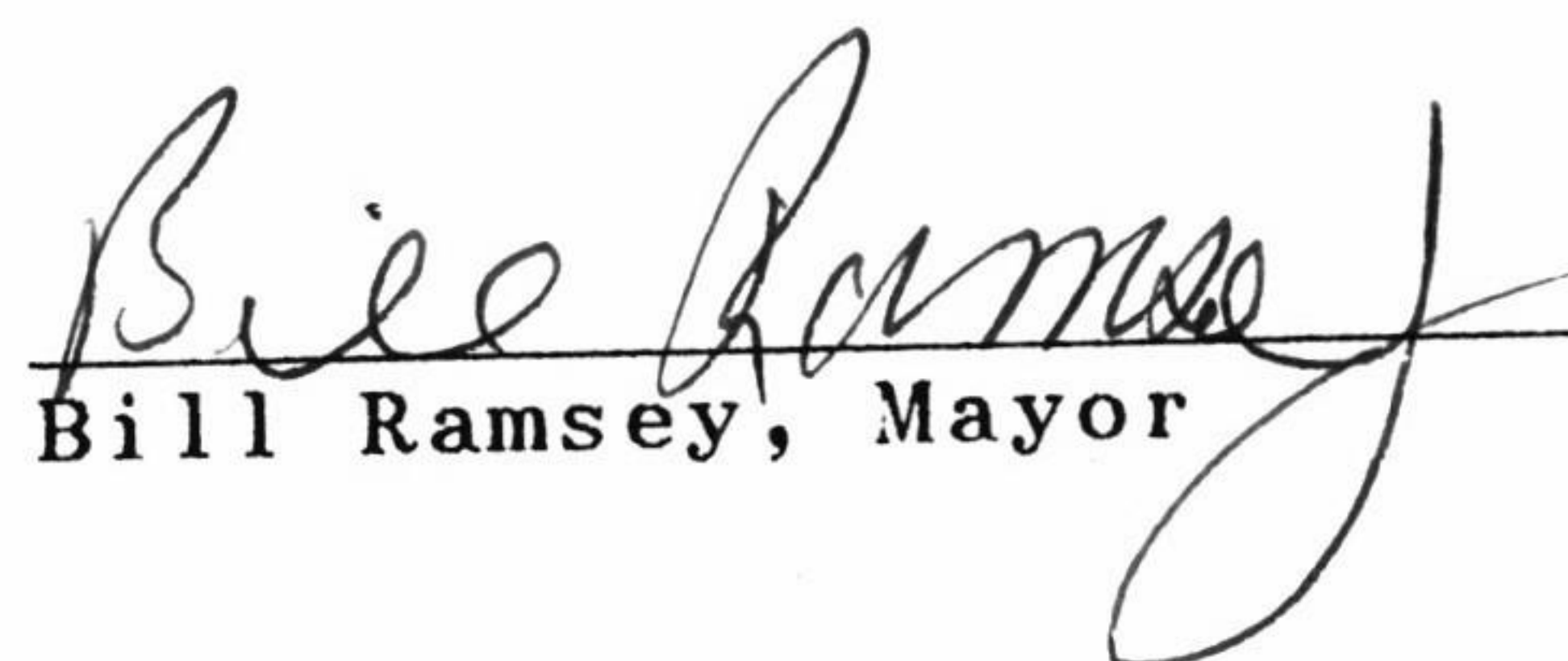
