MINUTES OF MEETING
OCTOBER 10, 1991

All members were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. They were, Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Eddie Wilson, and Dare Duncan.

Mayor pro-tem, Max Andrews, gave the invocation. Minutes of the last meeting stand approved.

On a motion made by Max Andrews, seconded by Eddie Wilson, council moved to transfer \$200,000.00 out of the general funds account, and \$100,000.00 out of the water department account to buy two savings certificates of the above figure. The savings certificates will be placed with Granite Savings bank, with the interest rate at 6.33% to mature in 12 months.

Paul Pope made the motion to pay approximately \$300.00 for the advertising of the 911 emergency telephone numbers expected to go into effect the last of October, 1991. Dare Duncan seconded with all in favor.

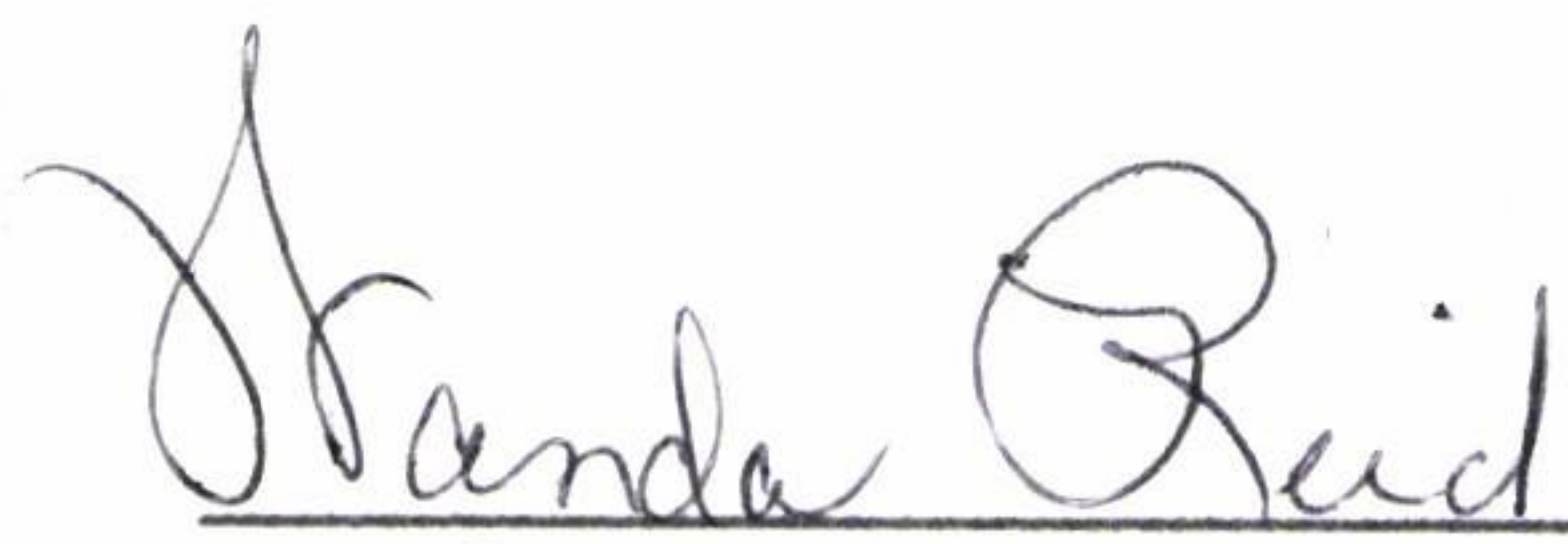

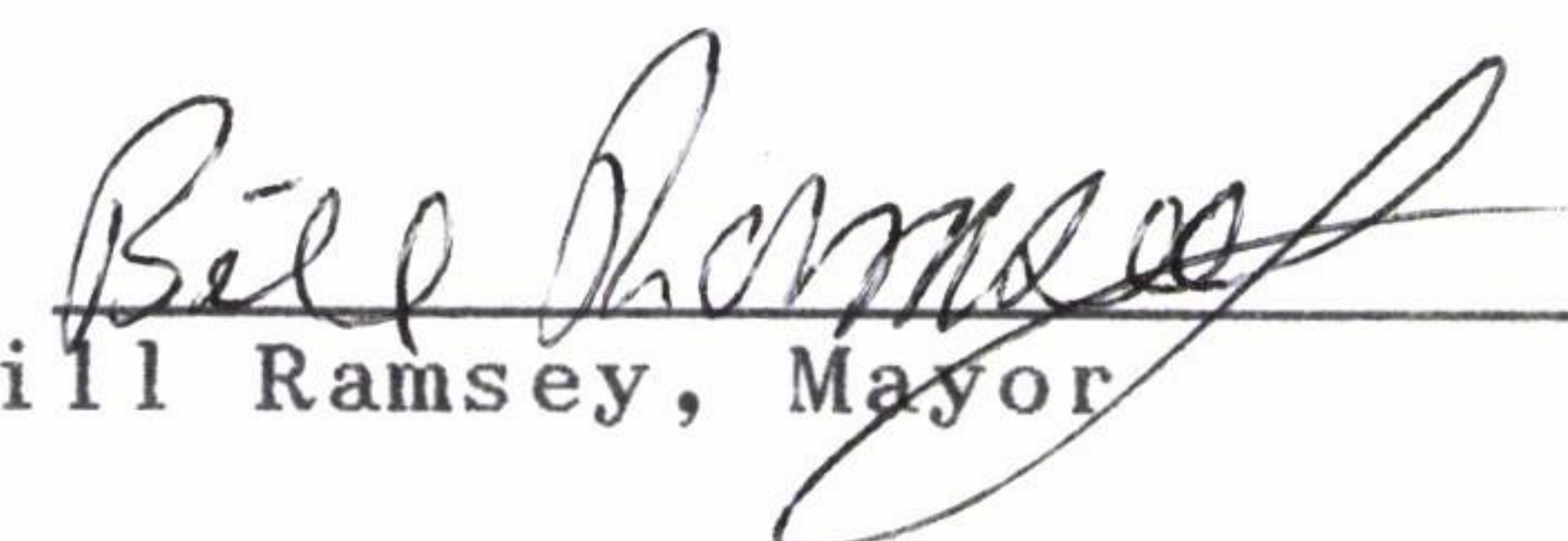
The appointing of two more Recreation Commission members was tabled until the next meeting.

With Dare Duncan seconding, Paul Pope made the motion to purchase 2 computer power packs from User Friendly instead of having the old power pack repaired. All were in favor.

At 5:50 PM, Dare Duncan made the motion to adjourn. All were in favor as Max Andrews seconded.
