

TOWN OF SAWMILLS MINUTES OF MEETING
OCTOBER 19, 1993--7:00 PM

Tim Sanders was absent as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. Present was; Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson and Larry Prestwood.

Invocation was given by Rev. Fred Hicks.

f., Executive Session was deleted. On a motion made by Dennis Wilson, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to adopt the agenda.

Dennis Wilson moved to approve the previous minutes of October 5, 1993, with Max Andrews seconding. All were in favor.

Max Andrews made a motion to pay the bills. Paul Pope seconded. Vote unanimous.

On a motion made by Max Andrews, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to allow the Town of Hudson to extend a sewer line to property located at the northwest corner of Horseshoe Bend Road and Cahah's Mountain Road, Sawmills, at the request of owners, Hubert and Pauline Mathes.

Larry Prestwood moved, with Paul Pope seconding, to accept the Bobby Hatley minor sub-division plat, located on Clyde Drive, as presented to council. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Larry Prestwood, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to accept a preliminary plat owned by Harold Duncan, located on Paul Drive, Sawmills.

Town Planner, Mike Legg, presented council with a Summary of Proposed Zoning Ordinance Amendments Concerning Manufactured Homes and Manufactured Home Parks. This will need studying and was tabled until after the new mayor and council were elected.

Mike also presented a Procedure for Initiating Extraterritorial Municipal Zoning that was also tabled until the new board was in.

On a motion made by Dennis Wilson, seconded by Larry Prestwood council moved that informal bids be taken for curbing the parking lot, a 70' x 24' covered picnic area, and a basketball court to be constructed in the town's park. All were in favor.

After some discussion, council decided on a tentative date of December 9, 1993, Caisey's, for the town's annual Christmas Dinner. The Christmas Parade is to be thought about and discussed again at the next meeting.

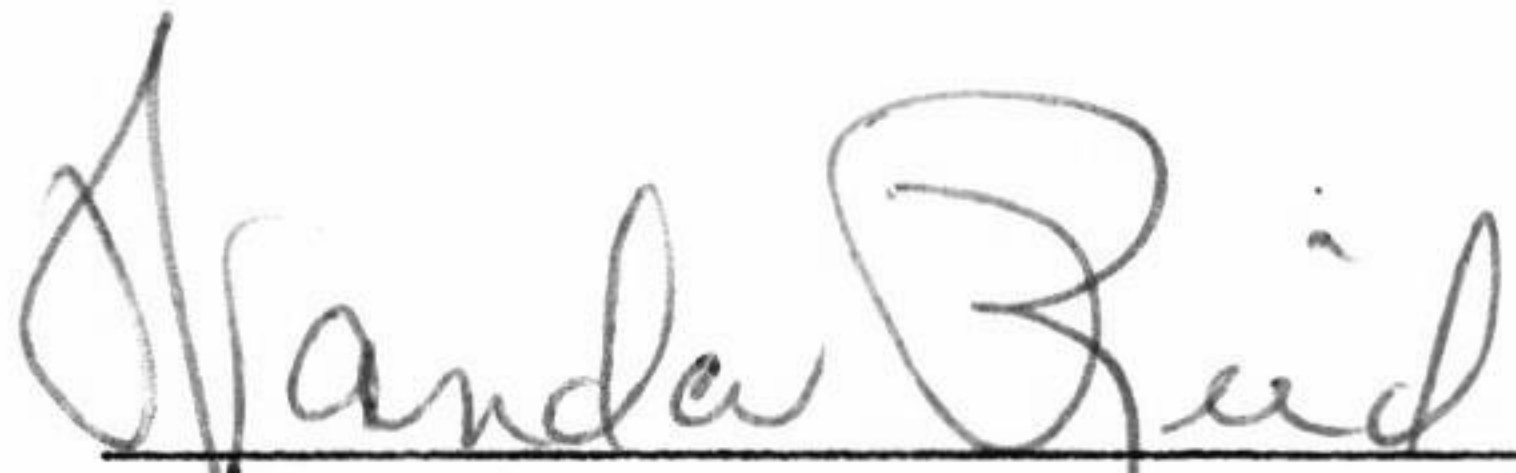
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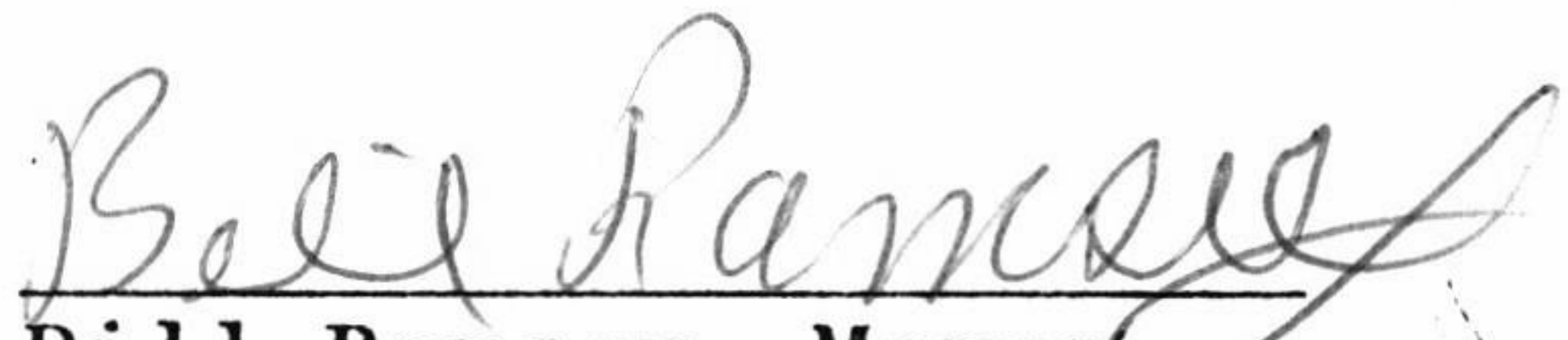
On a motion made by Larry Prestwood, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to table the meeting for discussion of employee personnel study until the new board was sworn in.
