MINUTES OF MEETING
October 23, 1990

Mayor Bill Ramsey presided over the regular meeting held on October 23, 1990 at 5:00 PM at town hall. Present were Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Maxine Stamey, CJ Baker, Paul Pope and Eddie Wilson.

Councilman CJ Baker delivered the invocation.

Minutes of the previous meeting held on October 9, 1990 were adopted, except that the date of the clean-up day is Nov. 3, 1990 instead of Nov. 4, 1990.

On a motion by Councilmember Pope, seconded by Maxine Stamey, Council moved that the towns lawyer, Terry Taylor write a letter to Caldwell County's Solid Waste Officer, asking him to enforce the towns Solid Waste Ordinance as the town would reimburse each call as placed by the towns Mayor.

Paul Pope made a motion requesting an amendment of the Towns Zoning Ordinance in order to appoint alternate members on the Board of Adjustments. Max Andrews seconded. All were in favor.

Motion was made by Maxine Stamey to accept the revised contract with Smith, Keener, & Stevens, PA. for the year ending June 30, 1990 to audit the books for the Town of Sawmills. Seconding this motion was Eddie Wilson. All were in favor.

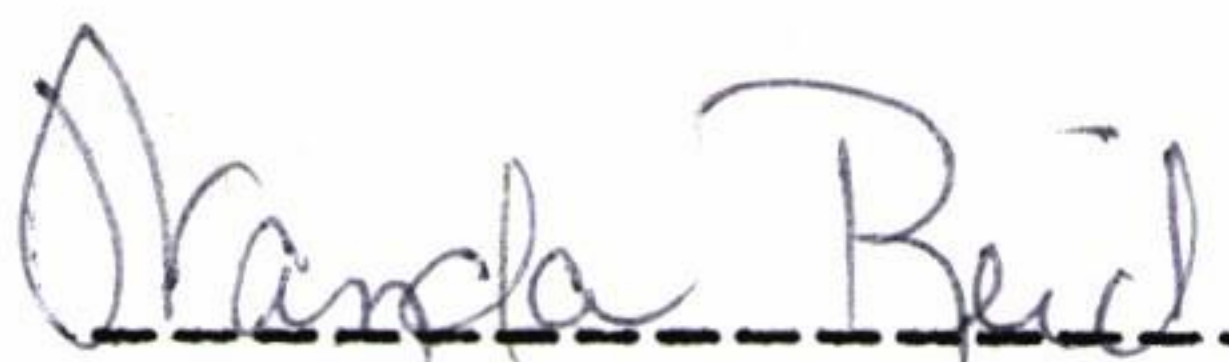
Recycling was tabled until the next meeting.

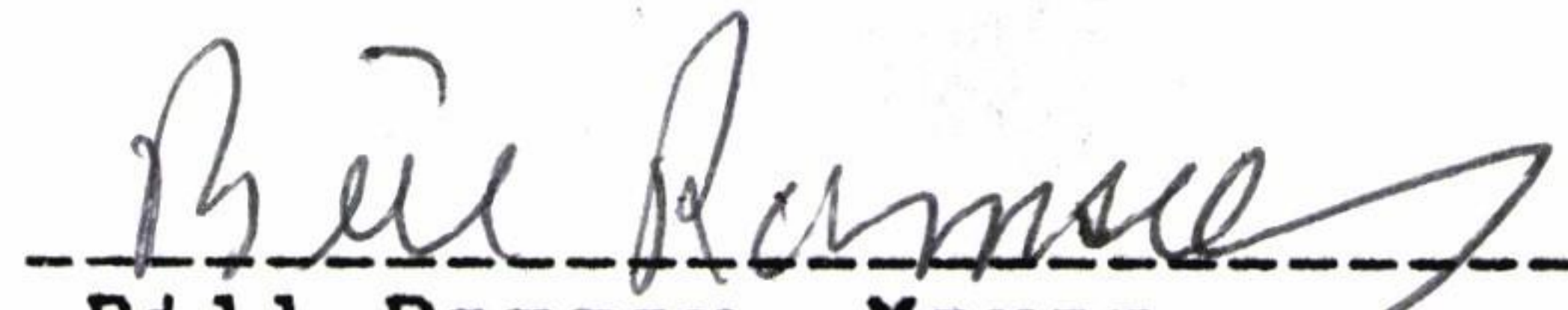
It was decided to have the Towns Christmas Dinner on Thursday, December 6, 1990. Councilmember Baker will make arrangements as to the location.
