

TOWN OF SAWMILLS MINUTES
NOVEMBER 2, 1993

All councilmembers were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. They were: Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood, and Tim Sanders.

Invocation was given by Dennis Wilson.

e., Loretta Teague, representative of Caldwell County Health Department and f., Executive Session was added to the agenda. Tim Sanders moved to adopt the agenda with Larry Prestwood seconding. All were in favor.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to approve the minutes of October 19, 1993.

Paul Pope moved, Larry Prestwood seconded to pay the bills. All were in favor.

The following motions and seconds were made on the continuing improvements of the town's park:

Tim Sanders moved that Granite Building Supply (\$4,188.65) be awarded the bid over Best Builders (\$4,699.68) for the building materials used for the construction of a 24-by 75-foot covered picnic shelter. Larry Prestwood seconded. All were in favor.

Tim Sanders moved, Larry Prestwood seconded, with all in favor to award Poarch Construction (\$2,000.00) over Mark Townsend (no bid) to do the labor needed on the picnic shelter.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to allow Caldwell Ready Mix (\$1,242.00) pour the concrete instead of Hamby Brothers (\$1,219.00) or Lenoir Ready Mix (\$1,219.00) with the Sawmills Optimist Club paying the \$23.00 over.

Tim Sanders moved, Dennis Wilson seconded that Bobby Crouch (\$424.00) do the labor on the concrete for the picnic area, instead of Bedford Townsend (\$400.00) with the Optimist Club paying the \$24.00 over Townsend's bid. All were in favor.

Tim Sanders made a motion that Valdese Concrete do approximately 1,250 linear feet of curbing at a cost of \$7,812.50 in the town park. Larry Prestwood seconded. Paul Pope voted for, Dennis Wilson opposed and Max Andrews did not vote.

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On a motion made by Max Andrews, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to have the annual Christmas Dinner on Thursday, December 9, 1993 at 6:30 pm at Caisy's.

Dennis Wilson made a motion to have the town's annual Christmas Parade on Saturday, December 4, 1993 at 10:00 am. Paul Pope seconded. All were in favor.

Tim Sanders moved, Dennis Wilson seconded, with all in favor to adopt the Policies and Procedures of the TOWN OF SAWMILLS 1993 SCATTERED SITE HOUSING PROJECT FOR LOW INCOME, ELDERLY AND/OR DISABLED, as presented by Billie Sperry Community Development Specialist.

On a motion made by Tim Sanders, seconded by Paul Pope, council moved to adopt the Town of Sawmills HOME Program SCATTERED SITE HOUSING REHABILITATION CAPITAL PROJECT ORDINANCE, as presented by Billie Sperry, Community Development Specialist.

Max Andrews made a motion to obtain applications for hiring of another employee which may be needed when the involuntary annexation comes into effect on January 1, 1994. Larry Prestwood seconded. All were in favor.

c., Maintenance building was discussed and no motion made at this time.

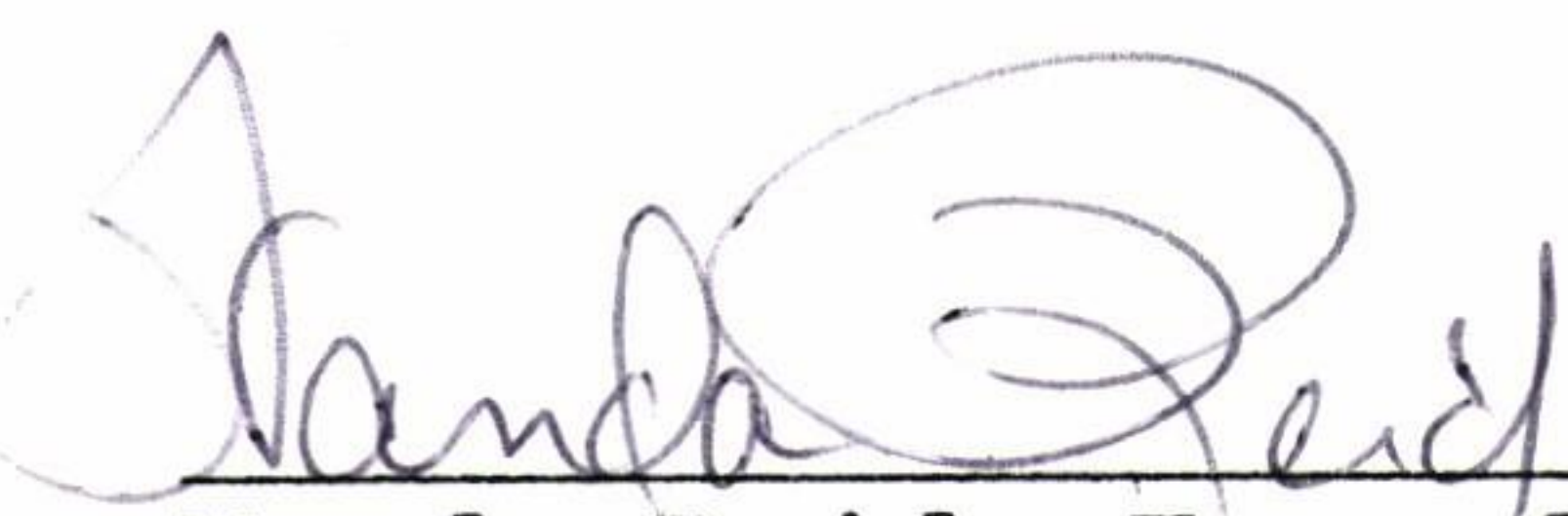

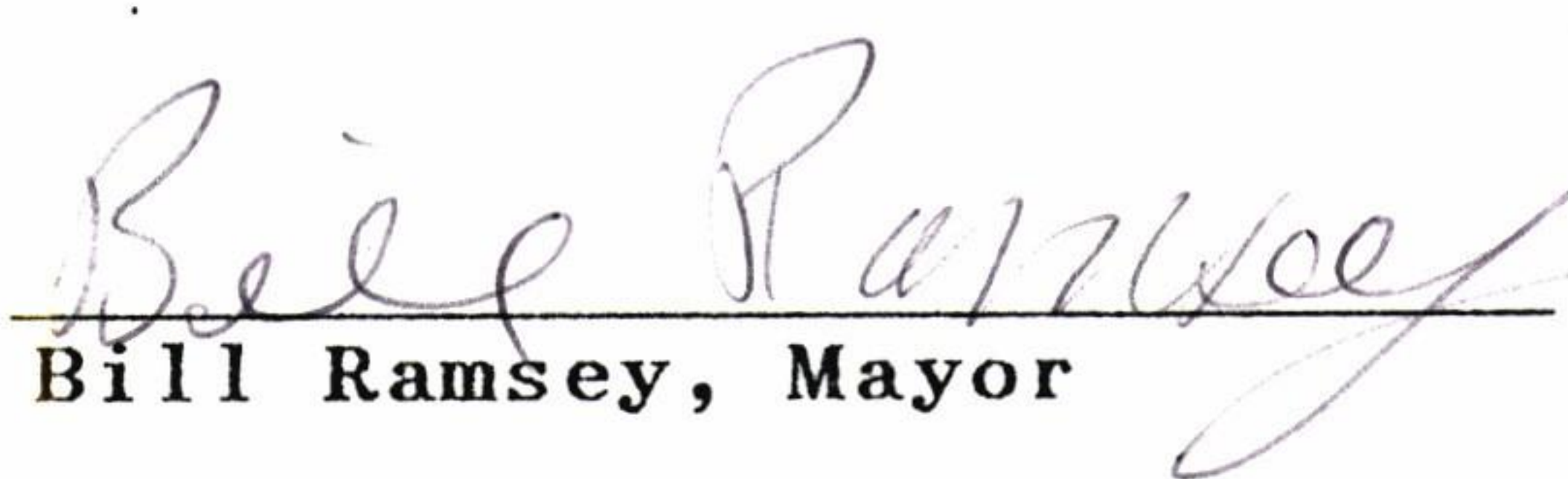
