

TOWN OF SAWMILLS
MINUTES OF MEETING
DECEMBER 10, 1991, 5:00 PM

All councilmembers were present as Mayor Bill Ramsey called the meeting to order. They were: Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Eddie Wilson, and Dare Duncan.

Invocation was given by Mayor Pro-tem Max Andrews.

Magistrate Joe Munday of Granite Falls, North Carolina swore the new members in. They were: Paul Pope for his second four year term, Larry Prestwood and Dennis Wilson for a four year term, and Tim Sanders, a two year term to finish out excouncilmember, CJ Bakers term. Mayor Bill Ramsey welcomed the new members to the board and expressed his appreciation of the service of Eddie Wilson and Dare Duncan during their time on the board.

Max Andrews made the motion to pay all bills with Paul Pope seconding. All were in favor.

The public hearing was opened on the rezoning of a piece of property located on 321A highway between Spring Lake Mobile Home Park and Baker Circle. Commercial Signs is requesting to be rezoned from R-15 (High Density Residential) to H-B (Highway Business). Tim Sanders made the motion to close public hearing. Dennis Wilson, seconded with all in favor.

On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Dennis Wilson, council moved to grant this request for rezoning.

GW Nester, a resident of Virginia Acres appeared before the board again about the property of Dorman Little. He acted very upset because there had apparently been nothing done by the town about this matter. Terry Taylor, the town's lawyer, explained to Mr Nester the town was following the state statutes and that after the required ninety days, the town would have the authority and could step in to repair and clean up this property.

Mayor Bill Ramsey reported to the board that the town of Sawmills and Lenoir Ford New Holland of Lenoir, North Carolina, had swapped the town's old back hoe for a new back hoe with a years warranty for one hundred fifty nine dollars.

Tim Sanders made the motion to appoint Max Andrews as mayor pro-tem. Dennis Wilson seconded with all in favor.

Max Andrews made the motion to appoint Tim Sanders as representative to Western Piedmont Council of Government with Paul Pope

seconding. All were in favor.

Tim Sanders related to the board that several of the residents of the town were complaining about the time of the council meeting, and he suggested the board consider meeting at 7:00 PM instead of 5:00 PM. A decision will be made at the next meeting.

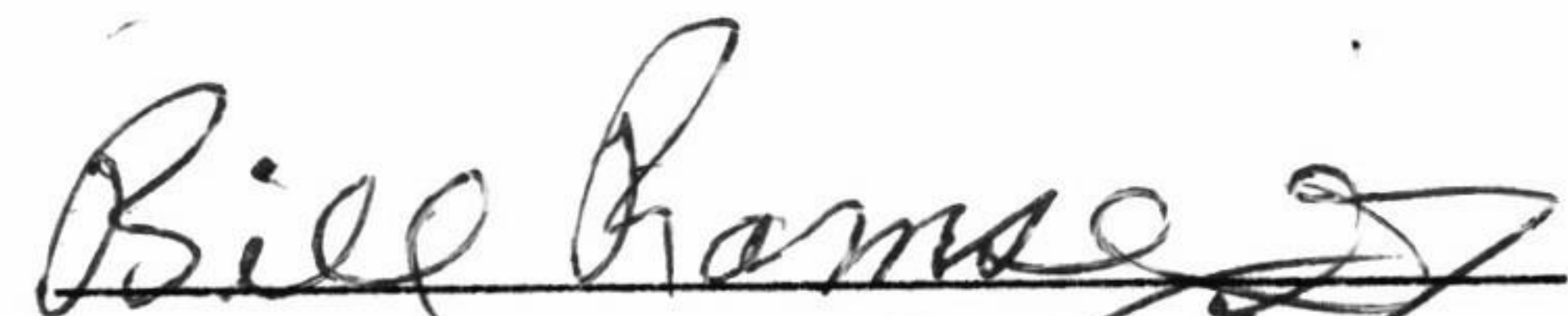
