ADOPT AGENDA: Bill Ramsey made the motion to adopt the agenda, with Joe Norman seconding. All were in favor.

APPROVAL OF DECEMBER 3, 2002 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES: On a motion made by Gerelene Blevins, seconded by Joe Helton, Council voted to approve the minutes of the previous meeting.

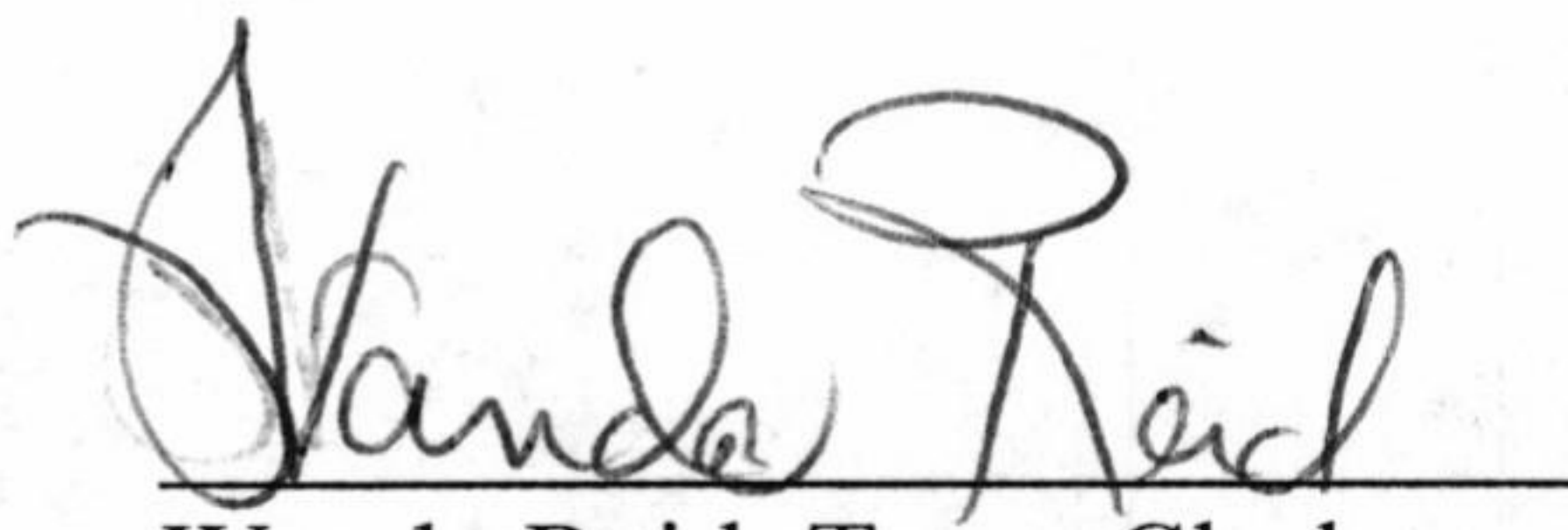

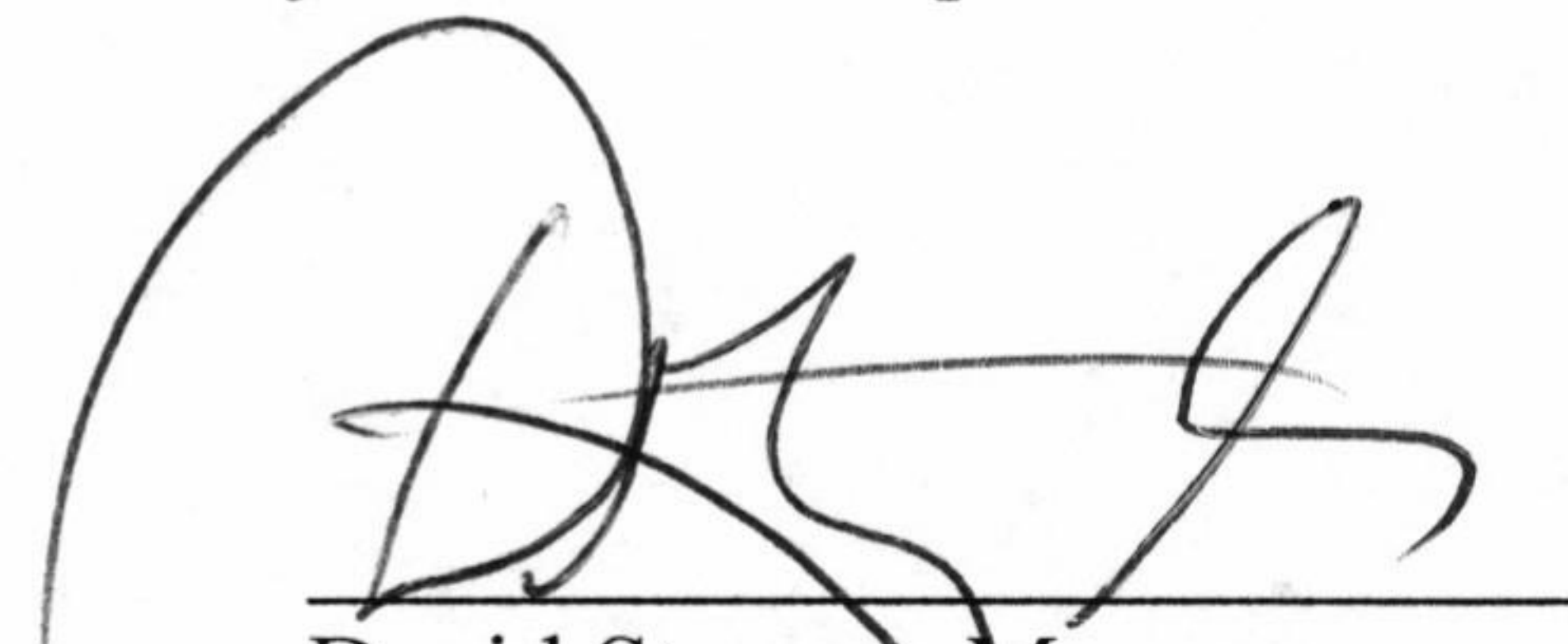
