JUNE 26, 1993, 5:00 PM AT TOWN HALL

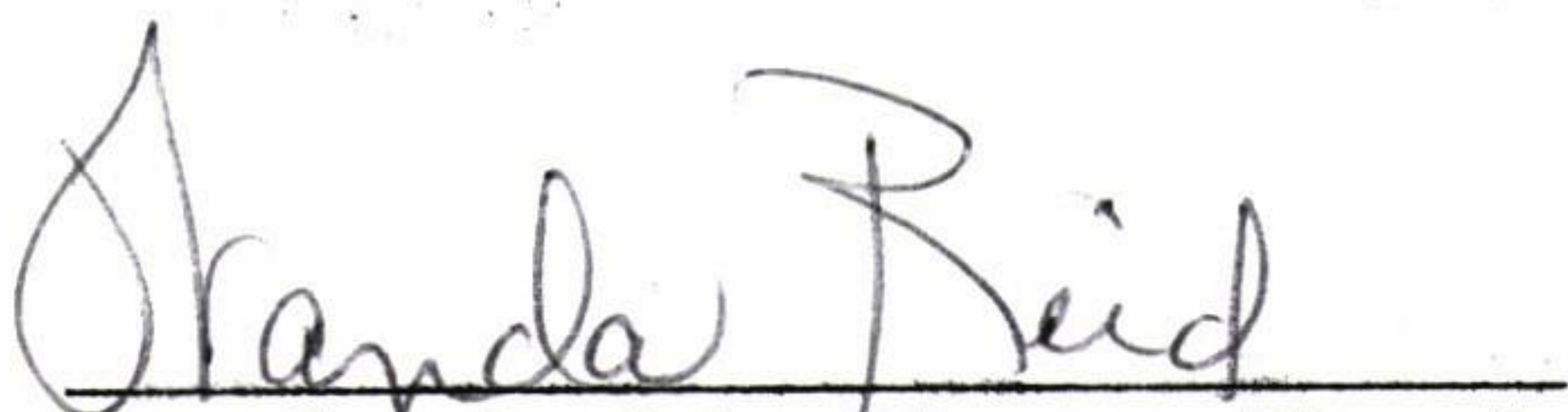
The special meeting to discuss employee wage scales, and a personnel policy was called to order by Mayor Bill Ramsey. Bill Ramsey, Max Andrews, Paul Pope, Dennis Wilson, Larry Prestwood, and Tim Sanders were present.

Invocation was given by Max Andrews.

Gene Dillman, Director of Personnel and Employee Relations Services, with the League of Municipalities, related to the board of the services the league had to offer to the Town of Sawmills. He proposed a study to conduct a comprehensive pay and classification study for the town. To study and evaluate all positions (regular, full-time) within the town for the purpose of determining the proper position classification and salary for each employee. To conduct a total review of the town's personnel policies as required to implement a modern program of personnel administration. To prepare a pay plan for the town as required to maintain a competitive system of salaries and wages. On a motion made by Paul Pope, seconded by Larry Prestwood, council moved to enter into a contract with the Management and Personnel Services (MAPS), under contract with the North Carolina League of Municipalities, to do a Personnel Service study for the Town of Sawmills.

Paul Pope made the motion to allocate a 5% pay raise to all employees. Dennis Wilson seconded. All were in favor.

At 5:50, pm, Dennis Wilson made a motion to adjourn. Tim Sanders seconded with all in favor.
