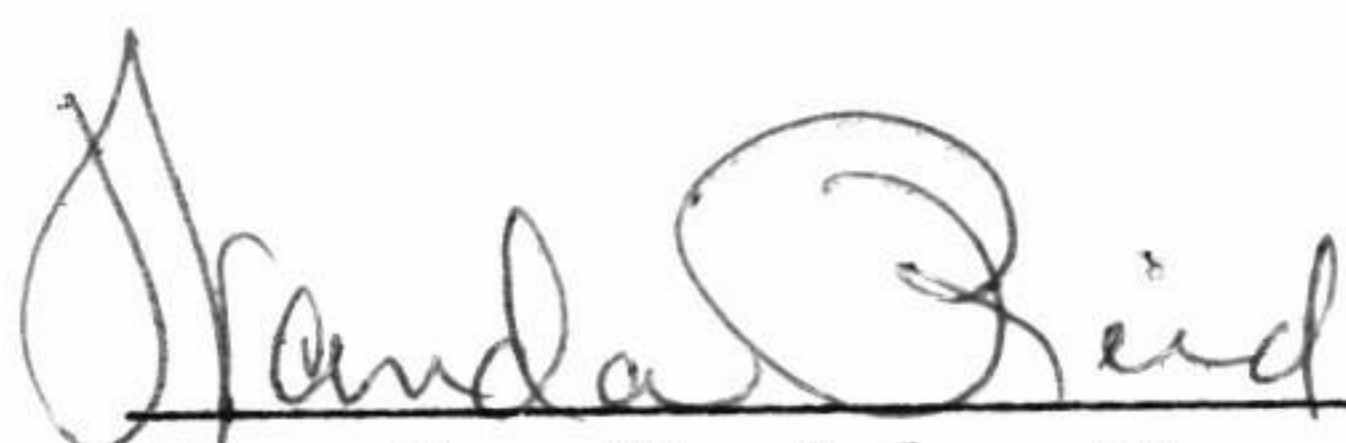
Invocation was given by Mayor Pro-tem, Max Andrews.

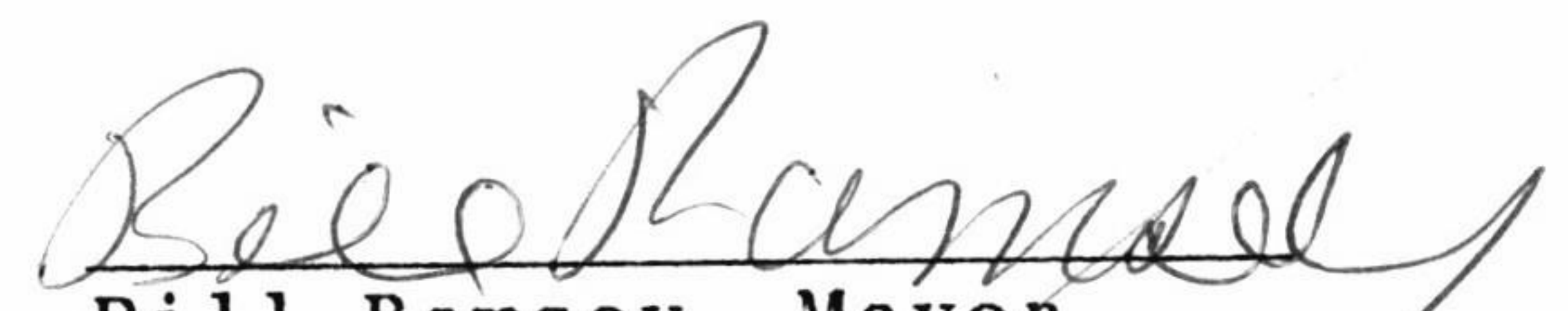
